Projects recently completed include a new roof on the community center and café, refurbished trash receptacles, replaced the old lava rock fence at the community center with stained picket fence, and the dance floor in the community center has been refurbished and looks like new. 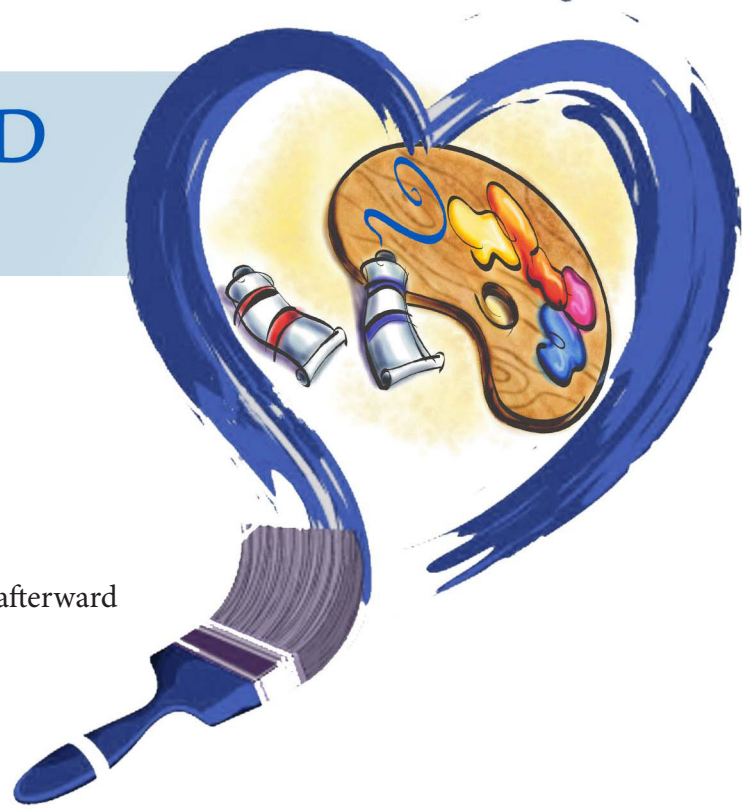
