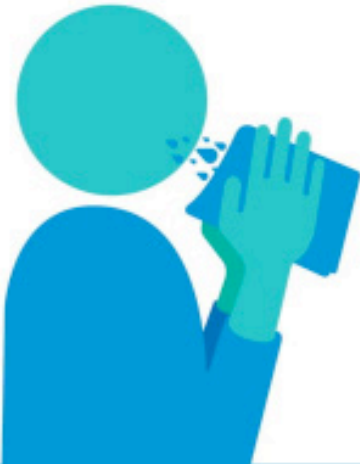


## REMEMBER THE 3 C's!

**FICTION**

The Wife Upstairs by Rachel Hawkins - *Fiction/Mystery/Thriller* –

A twist on a Gothic classic, pairing Southern charm with atmospheric domestic suspense. Supplementing her modest income by stealing small valuables from her gated-community clients, a broke dog-walker endeavors to win the heart of a wealthy bachelor before learning his late wife’s own rags-to-riches story.

Serpentine by Jonathan Kellerman – *Fiction/Thriller/Suspense* –

LAPD homicide lieutenant Milo Sturgis and brilliant psychologist Alex Delaware investigate a decades-unsolved case involving a rich and spoiled client, a mysterious birth mother and violent coincidences.

The Award by Danielle Steel – *Fiction/Historical Romance/WWII* -

Gaëlle de Barbet is sixteen years old in 1940 when the German army occupies France and frightening changes begin to occur. She is shocked and powerless when French gendarmes take away her closest friend, Rebekah Feldmann, and her family for deportation to an unknown, ominous fate.

On Nana’s Shoulders by Vicki Schoen – *Contemporary Women’s Fiction* -

This book was written by a local author and will be the Lake Tanglewood Book Club selection for April. A story of families—their unraveling and reconfiguring, of missteps and unexpected directions, of hard decisions, of love and hurt and all the consequences that follow.

The High Season by Judy Blundell – *Contemporary Fiction* -

“An acid-laced domestic drama set during one golden summer on the moneyed, beachy North Fork of Long Island.”—*The New York Times*. A wry, often hilarious story of a woman trying to keep it together when everything is going so, so wrong.

**AUDIOBOOKS**

Next to Last Stand by Craig Johnson/George Guidall - *Fiction/Mystery/Detective/Western* -

Longmire Series - One of the most viewed paintings in American history, Custer’s Last Fight, copied and distributed by Anheuser-Busch at a rate of over two million copies a year, was destroyed in a fire at the 7th Cavalry Headquarters in Fort Bliss, Texas, in 1946. Or was it? A Florsheim shoebox containing a million dollars sends the good sheriff on the trail of a dangerous art heist.

The Right Attitude to Rain by Alexander McCall Smith – *Fiction/Mystery/Women Sleuths* -

Book 3 of the Isabel Dalhousie series of novels featuring the insatiably curious philosopher and woman detective. When friends from Dallas introduce her to Tom Bruce, a Texas tycoon, Isabel Dalhousie turns sleuth to investigate Tom’s young fiancée, who may be more interested in Tom’s money than in Tom.

Criminal Paradise by Steven M. Thomas – *Fiction/Thriller/Crime* -

Robert Rivers is a crook. No excuses, no apologies. But he’s a thief with honor, plotting heists where no shots are fired, no blood is spilled, and nobody gets hurt—except in the wallet. After carving out a comfortable existence in sunny Southern California, Rob is thinking about quitting the game. But then he and his trusty partner, Switch, score a payday that could end up costing them plenty.

### Building Permits

*Village Ordinance requires most construction projects to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries. Failure to obtain a permit may result in a substantial fine.*

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT), or online at [www.laketanglewood.org](http://www.laketanglewood.org)

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon on the Friday of the week prior to the Building Committee Meeting to be considered.

Roofing Permits can be obtained during normal business hours, with the submission of a Roofing Permit application.
