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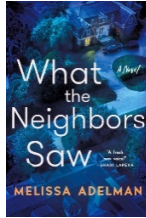
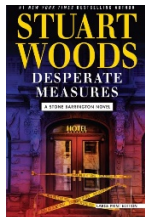
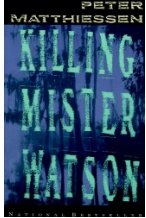

FICTION:

Killing Mister Watson by Peter Matthiessen - *Literary Fiction*

Drawn from fragments of historical fact, Matthiessen's masterpiece brilliantly depicts the fortunes and misfortunes of Edgar J. Watson, a real-life entrepreneur and outlaw who appeared in the lawless Florida Everglades around the turn of the century.

Desperate Measures by Stuart Woods – *Mystery /Thriller* – Stone Barrington Series

Upon returning to the states from a European jaunt, Stone Barrington makes the acquaintance of a stunning woman who seems like she could be an ideal candidate to meet some of his professional—and personal—needs. Before long, though, Stone is put to the task of protecting his new hire when New York City is rocked by a series of disturbing crimes, and it looks as if she might be the next target.

What The Neighbors Saw by Melissa Adelman - *Thriller/Suspense*

Desperate Housewives meets *The Couple Next Door* in a chilling story of murder and intrigue set in a well-to-do DC suburb. Sometimes the darkest acts occur in the most beautiful houses. The neighborhood's picture-perfect image is shattered when Teddy – a handsome, successful father of three – is found dead on the steep banks of the Potomac River. Tensions mount and long-buried secrets start to emerge.

Red On The River by Christine Feehan – *Thriller/Suspense*

Christine Feehan goes all in with this sexy romantic thriller set among the dangers – both man-made and natural – of Nevada's breathtaking landscape.
