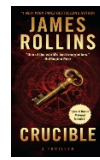

The 19th Christmas by James Patterson/Maxine Paetro – *Suspense/Thrillers* - #19 of the *Women's Murder Club* series

Detective Lindsay Boxer and her friends in the Women's Murder Club look forward to a calm holiday season, but a criminal mastermind known only as "Loman" unleashes credible rapid-fire threats by the hour. He is planning a deadly surprise for Christmas morning. Loman's greed – for riches, for bloodshed, for attention – is limitless. The month of December is upended and avoiding tragedy is the only holiday miracle the Women's Murder Club seeks.

The Shadow by James Patterson/Brian Sitts – *Thrillers/Suspense*
