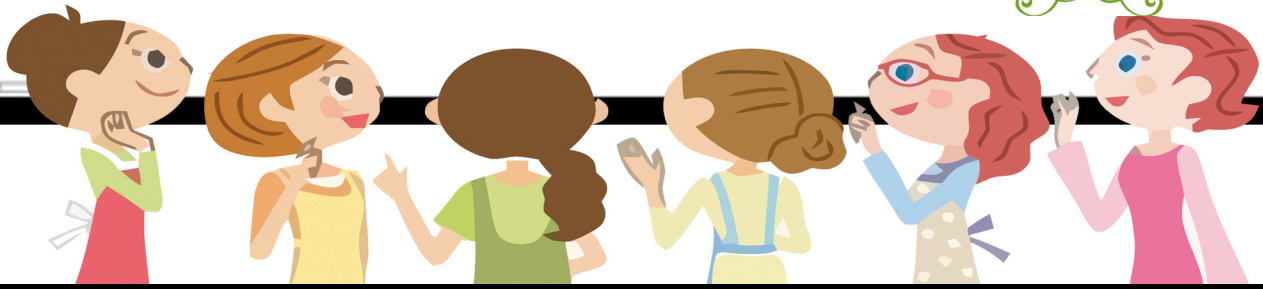

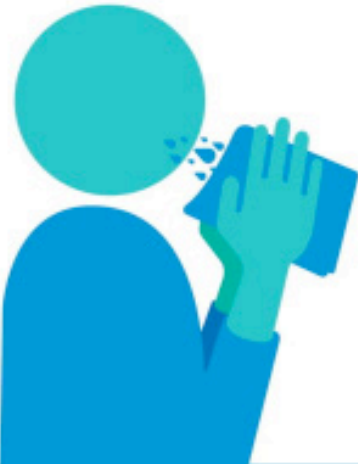


REMEMBER THE 3 C's!

LAKE TANGLEWOOD ANGLERS CLUB



We have completed our fall stocking program of 18,250 bass, 3000 hybrid striper/ white bass (to control the shad), 200 channel catfish and 2800 bluegill perch over 75 locations around the lake in early October. We also tagged about 250 of those bass with a red and green glow paint behind the back dorsal fin. If you catch one of these fish, please measure and weigh it and return it to the water, then call or text me the results. We can track their growth this way. At present we are building fish structures to put in specific areas around the lake. If you are wanting structure around your lakefront area, call or text me. I can send you pics and info. Please remember ALL bass caught must be returned to the water. They are an illegal species to keep at the lake. Signs are posted at the ramps. The Anglers Club and Lions Club will be monitoring this closely. What a great effort and many thanks to The Anglers Club, Lions Club and LSIOT for their support in this project. We also wish to thank all of the residents who donated funds to improve our fishery. And last but not least, the Fisheries Committee and all of the volunteers who helped us get the fish to drop-off points safely.

Building Permits

Village Ordinance requires most construction projects to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries. Failure to obtain a permit may result in a substantial fine.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT), or online at www.laketanglewood.org

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon on the Friday of the week prior to the Building Committee Meeting to be considered.

Roofing Permits can be obtained during normal business hours, with the submission of a Roofing Permit application.
