There are over 3800 items in the library – here are some of them:

- 1565 fiction books including a separate display of Inspirational
- 352 non-fiction books
- 443 primary books/audio
- 498 junior/young teen books/audio
- 678 audio fiction/non-fiction books on CD
- 69 DVD's including television series such as ***Downtown Abbey*** and ***Doc Martin***

Our entire inventory is available for checkout two weeks at a time - with no fees. Late fees are only 10 cents per day! We are no longer accepting donated items at this time.

These wipers are a fun to catch fighter as well as another method to enhance the control of the shad and carp problem. We are looking to add Florida hybrid strain bass into the lake next year as part of our maintenance program for the fishery. We also plan to offer another presentation on the algae control system after the holidays and when we can have the company representatives here to help answer questions.
