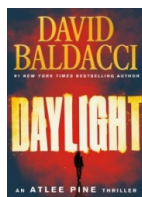
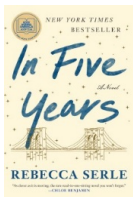
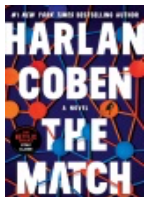

The Match by Harlan Coben - *Thrillers/Domestic*

After months away, Wilde has returned to the Ramapo Mountains in the wake of a failed bid at domesticity that confirms what he's known all along: He belongs on his own, free from the comforts and constraints of modern life.

Suddenly, a DNA match on an online ancestry database brings Wilde closer to his past than he's ever dreamed, and finally gives Wilde the opening he needs to track down his father. But meeting the man brings up more questions than answers.

In Five Years by Rebecca Serle - *Friendship*

Dannie Kohan, an ambitious lawyer, experiences an astonishing vision that could change her life forever. After contently falling asleep, Dannie awakens, suddenly in a different apartment, with a different ring on her finger, and beside a very different man. She spends one hour exactly five years in the future before she wakes again in her own home on the brink of midnight – but it is one hour she cannot shake. *In Five Years* is an unforgettable love story, but it is not the one you're expecting.

Daylight by David Baldacci - *Thrillers/Suspense* - An Atlee Pine Thriller

In this gripping mystery, FBI Agent Atlee Pine's search for her twin sister - who was abducted when six years old and never seen again - clashes with a military investigator's high-stakes case, leading them both deep into a global conspiracy from which neither of them will escape unscathed.

The Terminal List by Jack Carr – *Thrillers/Political* – The Terminal List series

Now, with the world on the brink of war and a weakened United States facing rampant inflation, political division, and shocking assassinations, a secret cabal of global elites is ready to assume control. And with the world's most dangerous man locked in solitary confinement, the conspirators believe the final obstacle to complete domination has been eliminated. They're wrong.

With the odds stacked against him, James Reece is on a mission generations in the making. Unfortunately for his enemies, the former SEAL is not concerned with odds. He is on the warpath. And when James Reece picks up his tomahawk and sniper rifle, no one is out of range.

Roofing Permit Applications can be completed and emailed to the Village Office for quicker turn around.

Inspections are completed by Robert Downing. Please call Mr. Downing to schedule regular building inspections (pre-pour, electrical, final etc.)

To schedule a boat dock inspection for membership transfer, please email the Village Office to be put on the list. Payment of \$95 must be paid prior to inspection and can be dropped off in the LSIOT or Village Offices.

All re-inspections cost \$95 and must be prepaid to the Village Office

March 2023

To all members, contractors, roofers, builders, landscapers:

As the spring season approaches, please be mindful of these items:

1. Hours of entry into Lake Tanglewood for projects are: **7:45 am -5:45 pm.**
2. **ALL PERMITTED WORK MUST BE: APPLIED FOR, APPROVED AND PAID FOR BEFORE WORK CAN BEGIN. ALSO, THE VILLAGE MUST HAVE CURRENT LIABILITY INSURANCE ON FILE.**

(all information and applications may be found at www.laketanglewood.org or in the LSIOT offices.

The permit must be visible at the project site. (inside front window or staked at the construction site)

3. **Failure to comply with permitting and/or failure to post permits may result in a fine.**
4. All permit enforcement will be overseen by the police chief.
5. **No dumping of grass, leaves or brush into the lake.**
6. Please observe all traffic rules as well as weight/load restrictions.
