The LG Sonic unit have been winterized for this year. Weather permitting, we will look at the startup date in March to revive them for 2025. Members around the lake have commented that is a difference in the shallow clarity of the water and a bluer tint of the lake at distance from the water. We also did not have the algae swill that we have seen in recent summers. Many thanks to the maintenance dept. here at the lake as well as the LG sonic technicians for keeping us in data and troubleshooting our units. Thanks to Dr. Jim Rogers for monitoring the water, analysis, and the other 50 things he does for our fishery and water.

Got a load of hybrid wipers coming the first week of December. These hybrid white bass and stripers help tremendously in regulating the numbers of shad and carp fry. The fishing has been good. We will stock Florida bass in the spring.
