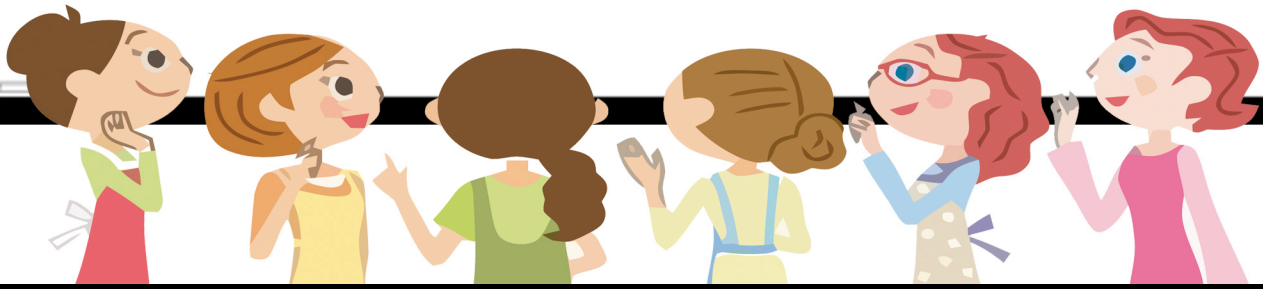

Women's Club is planning to start meeting again on Monday, February 1. If anything changes between now and then, Cheryl will send out an updated email. Stay well and blessed!

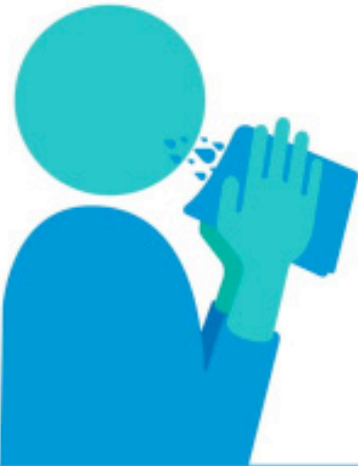


REMEMBER THE 3 C's!

FICTION

Good Grief by Lolly Winston - *Fiction/General* - author of Me For You – A widow’s fourteen-stage journey of recovery after the death of her spouse. Hoping to reinvent her life, she moves to Oregon. Instead of finding a Sam Shepard kind of guy, she finds herself involved in ever more hilariously confused adventures.

Paris Never Leaves You by Ellen Feldman - *Fiction/Historical/WW II* - Hiding her fateful past with a German officer during World War II, a Parisian bookstore clerk builds a new life for herself in the clubby, eccentric world of Manhattan publishing, before her daughter starts asking dangerous questions.

The Cold Millions by Jess Walter - *Fiction/Historical/Early 20th Century* - Enduring the corruption of their union employment, two young brothers who are day laborers witness an unjust world on the brink of turbulent class warfare of the early 20th century.

Three Women Disappear by James Patterson - *Fiction/Thriller/Suspense* - A man is murdered in his home. Sarah, his personal chef, Anna, his wife, and Serena, his maid, all had access. Now all three women are missing.

NONFICTION

I’ll Be Seeing You by Elizabeth Berg - *Nonfiction/Memoir* - *New York Times* bestselling author tells the poignant love story of caring for her parents in their final years in this beautifully written memoir.

AUDIOBOOKS

Cover of Night by Linda Howard - *Fiction/Romance/Suspense* - A young widow in rural Trail Stop, Idaho runs a B & B with the help of a local jack-of-all-trades, but he is not what he seems; her luck is about to run out.

Falling Awake by Jayne Ann Krentz - *Fiction/Romance/Suspense* - An expert in dream research, Isabel Wright finds her life becoming a nightmare when she loses her job at a sleep research center and she becomes involved with a client, Ellis Cutler, an operative for a classified government agency.

I Heard That Song Before by Mary Higgins Clark - *Fiction/Thriller/Suspense* - Marrying the son of her father's wealthy employer, twenty-eight-year-old gardener's daughter Kay Lansing becomes increasingly disturbed by the suspicion surrounding her husband, Peter, in regard to the mysterious deaths of his first wife and a high-school senior.

Sad Wind from the Sea by Jack Higgins - *Fiction/Thriller/General* - A gunrunner’s hunt for a fortune in gold leads to a life-and-death struggle in Communist China. The race to the sunken gold treasure quickly escalates into a bloody struggle for survival on the treacherous waters of the South China Sea.

The Wedding by Nicholas Sparks - *Fiction/Romance/Contemporary* - Bestselling follow-up to The Notebook. After more than twenty years of marriage, Wilson Lewis, son-in-law of Allie and Noah Calhoun, is forced to admit that the romance has gone out of his marriage. Inspired by Allie and Noah’s 50-year love affair, he is desperate to win back his wife Jane’s heart and must figure out how to make her fall in love with him again.

Building Permits

Village Ordinance requires most construction projects to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries. Failure to obtain a permit may result in a substantial fine.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT), or online at www.laketanglewood.org

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon on the Friday of the week prior to the Building Committee Meeting to be considered.

Roofing Permits can be obtained during normal business hours, with the submission of a Roofing Permit application.
