**FICTION**

How to Walk Away by Katherine Center – *Fiction/Women*

A contemporary Texan family is brought together after a devastating plane crash leaves one of their daughters (Margaret) in critical condition and prompts the return of their prodigal daughter, Kit. Margaret soon realizes that she's facing the unthinkable which turns her "perfect" life upside down. An unforgettable love story about finding joy even in the darkest of circumstances.

The Lost Years by Mary Higgins Clark – *Thriller/Suspense*

An aging biblical scholar is fatally shot after revealing his possession of the rarest of parchments believed to have been written by Jesus Christ. The parchment, stolen from the Vatican library in the fifteenth century, was assumed to be lost forever. Father Aiden O'Brien investigates the victim's suspicions that a most trusted biblical expert is determined to keep it from being returned to the Vatican.

The Wanted by Robert Crais – *Thriller/Suspense* – (author of Hostage book made into a movie starring Bruce Willis)

When single mother Devon Connor hires private investigator Elvis Cole, it's because her troubled teenage son, Tyson, is flashing cash and she's afraid he's dealing drugs. But the truth is devastatingly different. With two other partners in crime, he's been responsible for a string of high-end burglaries, a crime spree that takes a deadly turn when one of them is murdered and Tyson and his girlfriend disappear.

Typhoon Fury by Clive Cussler/Boyd Morrison – *Action & Adventure* – part of the Oregon Files series

When they are hired to track down a valuable art collection worth half a billion dollars, Juan Cabrillo and the crew of the *Oregon* find themselves sailing into much deeper waters involving a Filipino insurgency, a Japanese-developed drug to turn soldiers into super-warriors, and a South African mercenary.

Tom Clancy Power and Empire by Marc Cameron – *Thrillers/Suspense* – part of the Jack Ryan Series

Jack Ryan is dealing with an aggressive challenge from the Chinese government as the G20 Summit approaches. Pawns are being moved around a global chessboard: an attack on an oil platform in Africa, a terrorist strike on an American destroyer and a storm-tossed American spy ship that may fall into Chinese hands. It seems that Premier Zhao is determined to limit Ryan's choices in the upcoming negotiations.

High Profile by Robert B. Parker – *Mystery & Detective/Hard-Boiled* – part of Chief Jesse Stone series

Struggling with unprecedented levels of pressure during a high-profile case involving the murders of a controversial talk-show host and a young woman, Paradise police chief Jesse Stone encounters numerous dead ends and becomes increasingly frustrated by the lack of interest on the part of the victims' families.

The Breakdown Lane by Jacquelyn Mitchard/Anna Fields - *Fiction/Women*

Village Ordinance requires most construction project to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (as outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT) or online at [www.laketanglewood.org](http://www.laketanglewood.org)

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon the Friday prior to a Building Committee meeting (Wednesday).

Roofing Permits can be obtained by submitting an application during 'in office' hours
