The Cornwalls are Gone by James Patterson/Brendan DuBois – *Thrillers/Military*

Intelligence officer Amy Cornwall must use lethal tactics in open defiance of Army Command when a mysterious adversary kidnaps her family and gives her forty-eight hours to commit an unspeakable crime.

What Rose Forgot by Nevada Barr - Thriller/Suspense

A grandmother in her sixties emerges from a mental fog to find she's trapped in her worst nightmare. Rose Dennis wakes up in a hospital gown, her brain in a fog, only to discover that she's been committed to a nursing home Alzheimer's Unit. Something feels wrong and someone is determined to kill her.

Her Three Lives by Cate Holahan – *Thrillers/Domestic*

An up-and-coming social media influencer from the Caribbean and her fiancé, a successful architect from a privileged family, find their bond tested by disapproving relatives, a traumatic home invasion and growing suspicions about each other. A family must determine who the real enemy is.

The Iron Dragon's Mother by Michael Swanwick – Fantasy/Dragons & Mythical Creatures

After returning from her first soul-stealing raid, Caitlin of House Sans Merci, a half-human pilot of a sentient mechanical dragon is framed for her brother's murder and must search industrialized Faerie for the one person who can clear her name.

The Things We Cannot Say by Kelly Rimmer – Family Life/General

In 1942, Europe remains in the relentless grip of war. Just beyond the tents of the Russian refugee camp she calls home, a young woman speaks her wedding vows. It's a decision that will alter her destiny and it's a lie that will remain buried until the next century.

The Paris Library by Janet Skeslien Charles – Historical/World War II

Based on a true story, describes how a lonely, 1980's teenager befriends an elderly neighbor and uncovers her past as a librarian at the American Library in Paris who joined the Resistance when the Nazis arrived.

<u>Long Road to Mercy</u> by James Baldacci – *Thrillers/Suspense* – Part of "Atlee Pine" series

Devoting her life to bringing criminals to justice after her twin is murdered in childhood, FBI agent Atlee Pine investigates a missing-persons case in the Grand Canyon that may be tied to a string of disappearances.

Where the Lost Wander by Any Harmon – *Historical/General*

Set on Overland Trail in 1853, a young widow sets off with her family for a life out West – a journey fraught with hardship, fear, death and terrible sacrifice that leads her into the arms of a half-Pawnee man straddling two worlds.
