LT LIONS CLUB



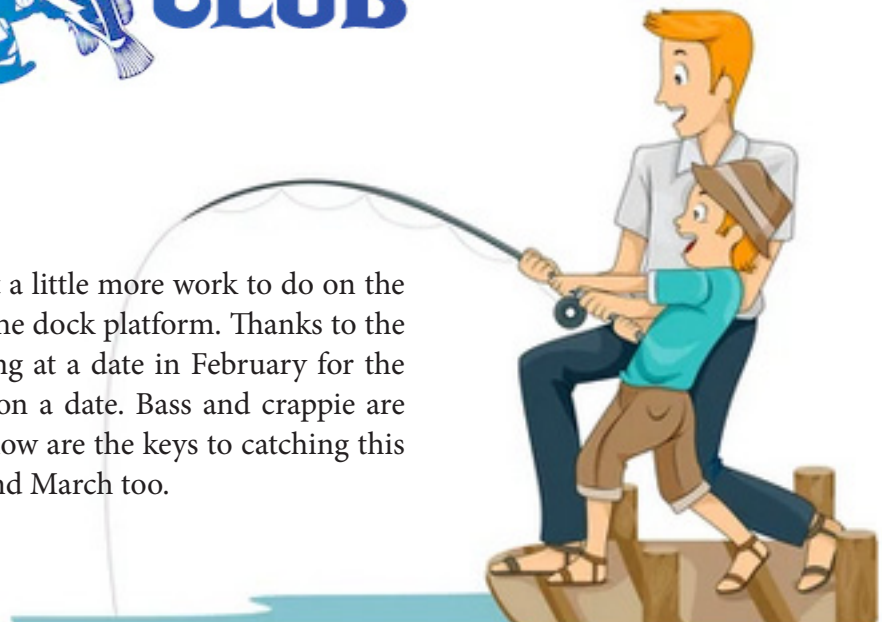
