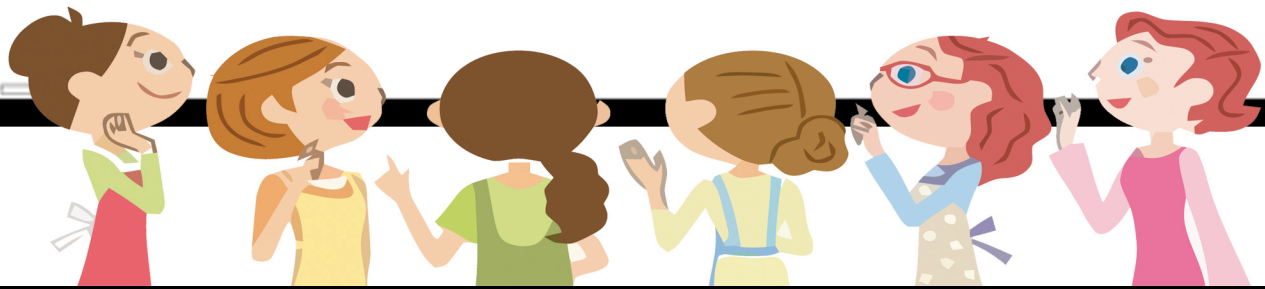

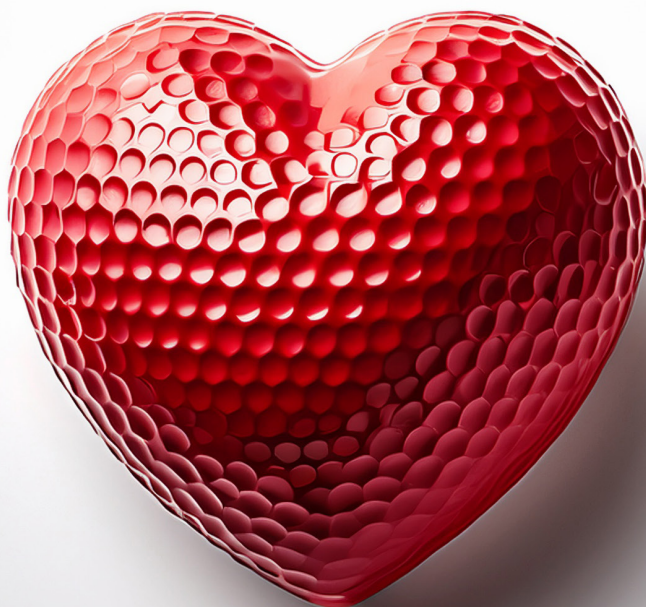
Not much to report this time so I will get to this year's proposed schedule for our scrambles. Please keep in mind these dates are not final. Watch for postings on the marquee.

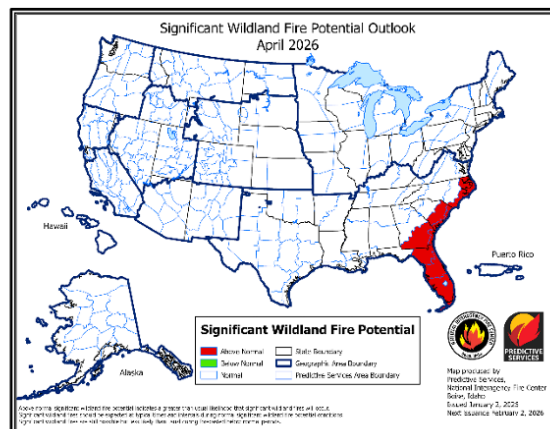
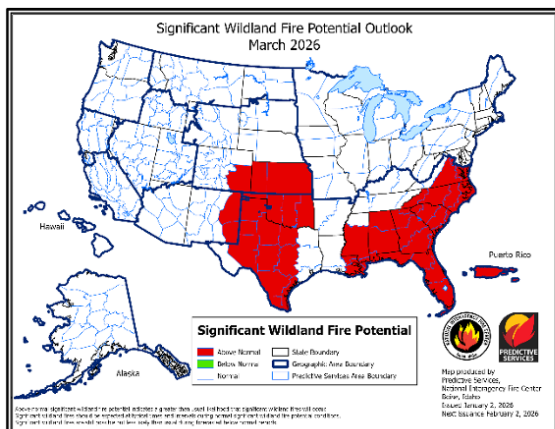
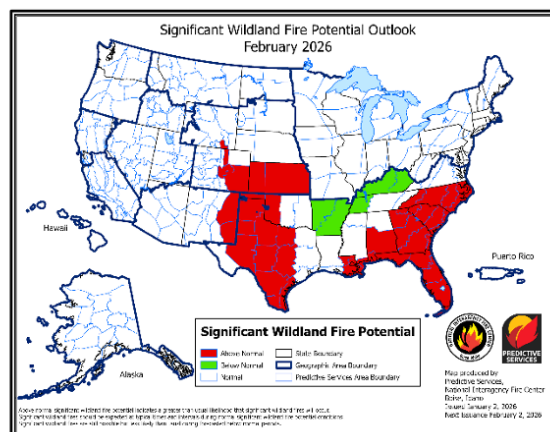
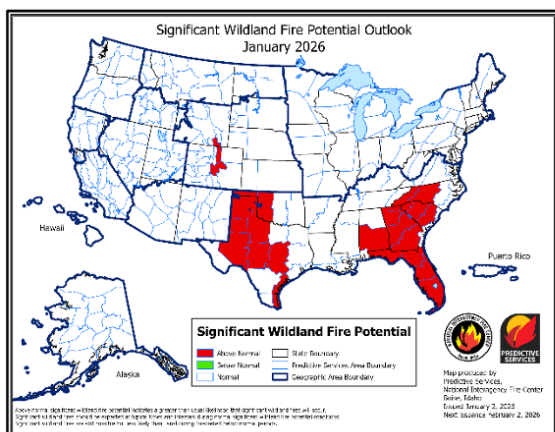


February 2026

Lake Tanglewood Fire Department had a busy year in 2025. During 2025 we saw a slight decrease in medical calls and a slight increase in fire calls. Training sessions also increased in 2025 primarily due to monthly joint medical training sessions with Randall County Fire Department and BSA Ambulance Service. The joint medical training sessions with all 3 agencies helps to assure the best continuity of care that we can provide and that all of our patients are properly assessed, treated and promptly transported to the hospital when necessary. Below is the 2025 Annual Summary of LTFD calls:

Call Type	2023	2024	2025
Community Service	7	3	7
Fire	26	28	37
Medical	47	44	37

It is also time to increase our community awareness of Wildfire conditions as we move from winter to spring. The Predictive Services of the National Interagency Fire Center has issued their most recent Wildfire projection estimates on January 2nd, 2026. As you can see below the Texas Panhandle area does not look good until we get to April. While we are Thankful for the rains we had last year it produced a tremendous amount of fuel on the ground which is now very dry, will burn easily and can spread rapidly with any wind so please be careful.





We would encourage you to go online and search for the “Ready Set Go Program” which provides great tips to on how to prepare your home and property around your home from wildfires. There is also a checklist of tips to prepare for an approaching wildfire and/or evacuation if that becomes necessary.

Lake Tanglewood Fire Department is always looking for men and women to volunteer to serve our community. There are many different jobs that are required to keep the department up and running.
