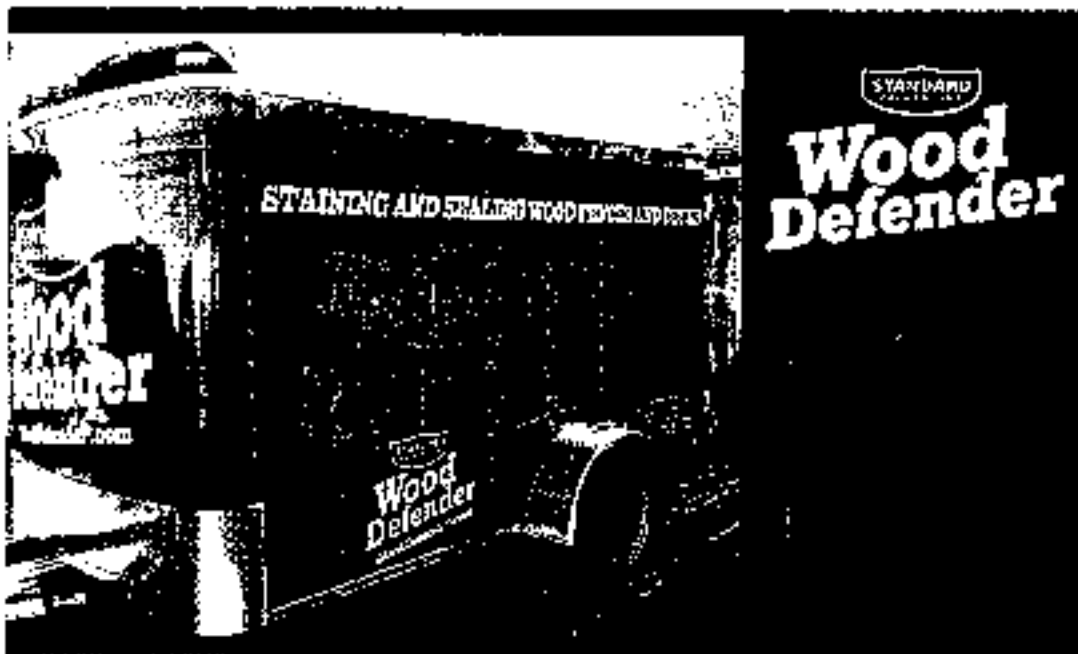

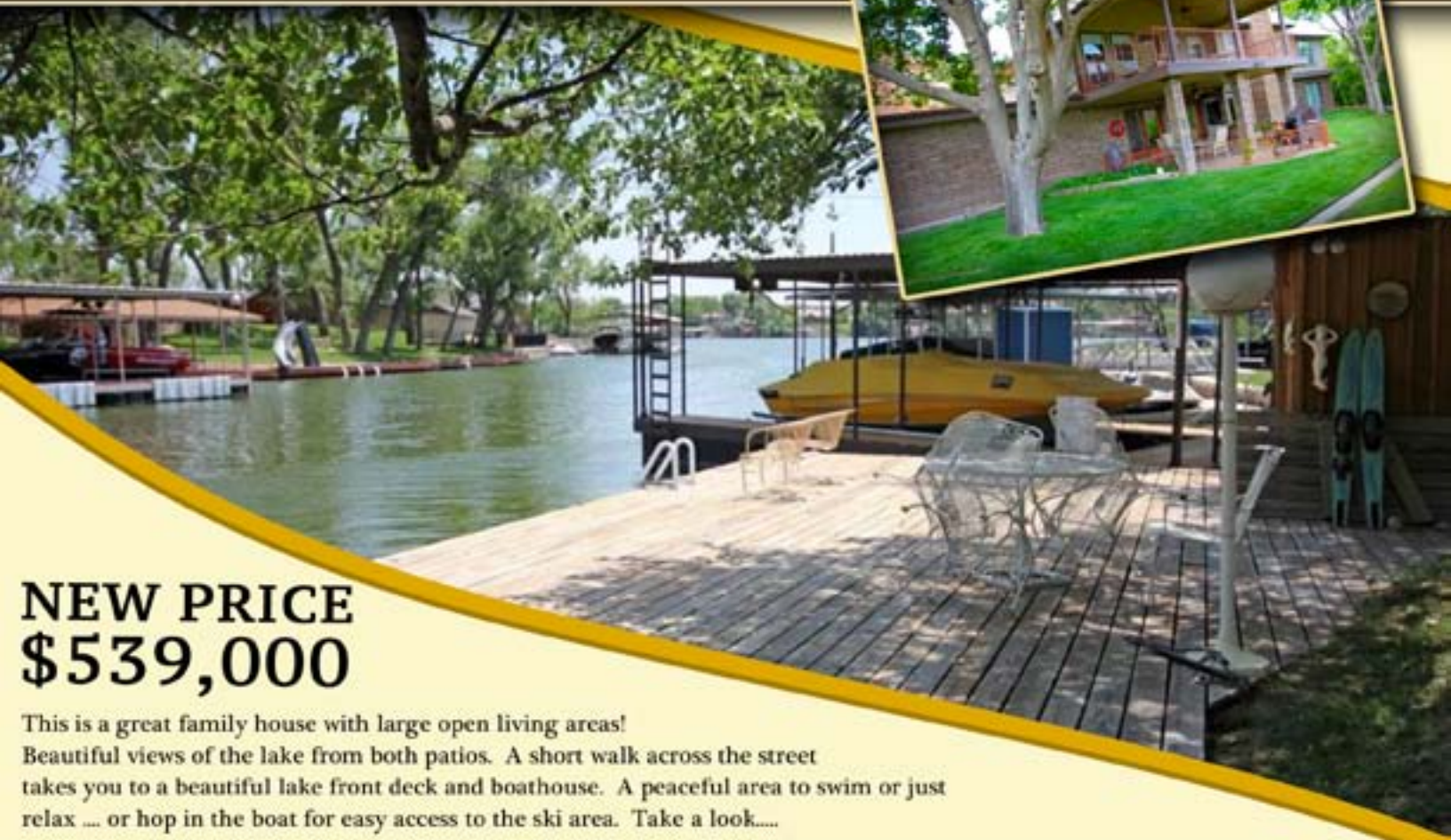

#### **FICTION**

**THE SINS OF OUR FATHERS**, By Jeffrey Archer. Harry Clifton, facing dashed hopes in England, joins the Merchant Navy during WWII. When his ship is sunk by a U-boat and only a handful survives, he assumes the identity of a dead American, hoping for a chance at a new life. Until he discovers what is awaiting the American in New York. Unable to prove his true identity, he is chained to a past far worse than the one he had hoped to escape.

**MEAN STREAK**, by Sandra Brown. Emory and the police suspect her husband. When she regains consciousness, she is the captive of a mysterious man. She begins to wonder if he is, in fact, her rescuer.

**RUN**, by Andrew Grant. Marc Bowman, a highly successful computer consultant and software designer, walks into his job at a major tech company one morning only to find himself fired on the spot. Then things get worse: An explosive argument drives his wife away and a robbery threatens to yank a million-dollar idea—and his whole future—out from under him.

**THE RED QUEEN**, By Philippa Gregory. A tale of conspiracy, passion, and coldhearted ambition, by the author of *The White Queen*.

**LEAVING TIME**, by Jodi Picoult. Jenna has never stopped thinking about her mother who disappeared mysteriously. She enlists a psychic and jaded private investigator in her quest to find out what really happened to her mother.

**TRUTH BE TOLD**, By Hank Phillippi Ryan. Investigating the case of a family evicted from their suburban, home, reporter Jane Ryland learns the truth About a big-bucks foreclosure scheme and the players who will stop at nothing, including murder, to keep their goal a secret. Third in the Jane Ryland series.

**ROSE HARBOR IN BLOOM**, By Debbie Macomber. Jo Marie enlists handyman Mark Taylor to help her create a rose garden for her inn and finds comfort in his company. Meanwhile, one guest struggles with a broken engagement, and another, a high-powered business, has returned to the area to make amends with a love she abandoned 20 years ago.

**TUMBLEWEEDS**, By Leila Meacham. From the author of *Roses*.

Three young friends – the saint, the sinner, and the angel – grow up together in the sort of small Texas Panhandle town that lives and dies by its Friday night football games. A fateful event casts a long shadow over these three intertwined lives.

**DON'T GO**, By Lisa Scottoline. As Dr. Mike Scanlon operates on a wounded soldier in war-torn Afghanistan, his wife Chloe dies at home in the suburbs, in an apparent household accident. When he returns home to bury her, he learns a shocking secret that sends him into a downward spiral. He realizes the biggest battle of his life faces him on the home front, and he'll have to put it all on the line to save his baby girl.

**LONGEST RIDE**, by Nicholas Sparks. An elderly man's dead wife helps him remain alert after a car crash by recounting the stories of their lifetime together. And a few miles away, a college woman is falling in love with a young cowboy. The lives of these two disparate couples will converge with unexpected poignancy.

### **NON-FICTION**

**KILLING PATTON**, By Bill O'Reilly. General George S. Patton, Jr., died under mysterious circumstances in the months following the end of WWII. For 70 years there has been suspicion that his death was not an accident – and may have been an act of assassination. O'Reilly goes inside the final year of the war and recounts the events surrounding Patton's tragic demise, naming the many powerful individuals who wanted him silenced.

**KILLING LINCOLN**, By Bill O'Reilly. In one of the most dramatic incidents in American history, one gunshot changed the country forever. After John Wilkes Booth assassinated President Lincoln, a brilliant, enigmatic New York detective (and former Union spy) unraveled the string of clues leading to Booth, while federal forces tracked his accomplices. History that reads like a thriller.

**THE IMPERIAL CRUISE**, By James Bradley. In 1905, Teddy Roosevelt's Secretary of War, William Howard Taft, headed a mission to Japan, the Philippines, China, and Korea. There he forged a series of agreements that divided up Asia. Decades later, these secret pacts lit the long fuse on the Asian firecrackers that would singe America's hands for a century.

**I AM MALALA**, by Malala Yousafzai. Noble Prize winner, 15 year old Malala Yousafzai refused to be silence and fought for her right to an education. As a result she was shot in the head on a school bus and almost died. (Young Adult)

**A RULE AGAINST MURDER**, by Louise Penny. The memorial held at the Manoir Bellechasse in remote Quebec brings together a family that harbors secrets and rivals. Chief Inspector Armand Gamache finds himself in the middle of a murder investigation and a hotel full of suspects. 4<sup>th</sup> in the series.

**MR. MIRACLE**, by Debbie Macomber. Harry Mills is a guardian angel tasked with helping Addie Folsom get her life back on track and help her find love.

**THE PERFECT WITNESS**, by Iris Johansen. She had the perfect life. She had the perfect cover. She was the perfect witness, until they found her. Now she's on the run.

### **YOUNG ADULT**

**MAZE RUNNER**, by James Dashner. No one knows why they're in the Glade, an unsolvable maze. Thomas can't remember how he got there.

**THE SCORCH TRAILS**, by James Dashner. Solving the Maze was supposed to be the end. Thomas was sure that escape meant they would get their lives back. But what are they going back to?

**THE DEATH CURE**, by James Dashner. As the third Trial ends, Thomas and some of his cohorts manage to escape from WICKED, their memories having been restored. But will that mean more danger?

**KILL ORDER**, By James Dasher. Prequel to the Maze Runner series. Before WICKED was formed, before the Glade was built, before Thomas entered the Maze, sun flares hit the earth and mankind fell to disease.
