Dear Members,

At the upcoming 2022 Annual Meeting, members will be voting to fill two Board of Directors positions; as well as voting to extend the Five-Year Sunset Fund, which is set to expire in March 2022. In 2017 at the Annual Meeting, the membership voted to approve a five-year sunset fund to support the capital budget of LSIOT. This \$21 per member per month (currently included with dues) is vital to support capital improvements and future needs. The renewal of the sunset fund is not an increase of your current overall monthly bill, and dues will stay the same.

Informational meetings are scheduled for January 4th and 11th at 6pm in the community center.

Some of the many improvements made possible by the sunset fund over the last five years:

- New Park Restrooms
- New Dependable Fuel Dispensers
- Remodeled Community Center
- Dredged Crappie Hole (cove that receives constant flow of water from City of Amarillo)
- Split Rail Fence around Golf Course
- Upgraded Gate Entry System for additional security
- Equipment Cover for Maintenance
- Purchased Equipment for Maintenance
- Repaired Camino Alto Drainage
- Sea Wall and Sidewalk around the Community Center and Restaurant Area
- Pergola for the Community Center and Restaurant
- Emergency Generator for the Gate, Office, and Public Water Pumphouse
- Water Monitoring and Level Alarm System for Public Water System

Lake Tanglewood is wonderful and unique place to live. Our goal is not only to maintain Lake Tanglewood, but to improve the overall quality of service, property, and amenities for the membership.

Your “yes” vote to extend the \$21/month/member sunset fund for another five years would be appreciated.

Between You & Me by Susan Wiggs - *General Fiction/Women*

Deep within the peaceful heart of Amish country, a life-or-death emergency shatters a quiet world to its core. Number-one *New York Times* bestselling author Susan Wiggs delivers a riveting story that challenges our deepest-held beliefs.

Arrowood by Laura McHugh - *Thrillers/Suspense* - Author of The Weight of Blood

Arrowood is the most ornate and grand of the historical houses that line the Mississippi River in southern Iowa. But the house has a mystery it has never revealed: It's where Arden Arrowood's younger twin sisters vanished on her watch twenty years ago—never to be seen again. When her father dies and she inherits Arrowood, Arden returns to her childhood home determined to discover what really happened to her sisters that traumatic summer.

1st Case by James Patterson - *Thrillers/Technological*

Recruited into the FBI when her unorthodox programming skills get her kicked out of MIT, a computer genius tracks a killer who has been targeting young women through a sophisticated messaging app.

Oona Out of Order by Margarita Montimore - *Fiction/Women* (A Good Morning America Book Club Pick)

Building Permits

Village Ordinance requires most construction project to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (as outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT) or online at www.laketanglewood.org

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon the Friday prior to a Building Committee meeting (Wednesday).

Roofing Permits can be obtained by submitting an application during 'in office' hours
