

# THE RUSSELL ACTIVITY CENTER

#### **History**

A generous gift from the Lee and Natalie Russell Estate to the Lake Tanglewood Community Church has made it possible to not only repair the court area located at the church, but to transform it into an amazing venue for the entire community: The Russell Activity Center (RAC).


#### **Features**

The RAC plans include impressive indoor and outdoor amenities, including resurfacing of the outdoor tennis and basketball courts, addition of a pickleball court, golf car parking, covered seating near the basketball and tennis courts, new fencing and lighting, and 24/7 accessible indoor restrooms. The crown jewel of the project will be a 45'x100' building containing a 45'x25' combination youth room/event space and a 45'x75' indoor gymnasium for basketball, walking, and other sports and events. Remember, this facility will be open to the entire community!

#### How You Can Be a Part


*Cost* As of June 5, we have raised \$344,000, or 76% of the total cost of \$450,000. Additional funds are needed to enclose the gymnasium, add court lighting and a new fence, and to cover contingencies.
