Slippery Boat Ramps

Lake Tanglewood has two very slippery boat ramps and we have had a few vehicle dunkings this summer. I have been loading and unloading boats for over 50 years and I almost went in once on the South Shore ramp. So these slippery ramps can be a problem for experienced and inexperienced boaters alike. Here a few pointers that might help out.

- Most boaters put their trailers too far into the lake. I my experience, putting the trailer in so
 that you can see the tops of the fenders will allow loading and unloading without getting your
 back tires in the water.
- 2. Remember when you have your foot on the brake you have engaged both the front and back brakes. However, when you put the car in park you only have the rear brakes engaged. Try to have someone in the car with the brake depressed.
- 3. If you have a 4X4 be sure it is in engaged so you have both the front and rear brakes engaged.
- 4. If you don't have a 4X4 and need to load by yourself use a brake peddle compression device. These can be purchased from Amazon for around \$30.00. Push the brake down and this device is placed on the brake peddle and then a slide is pulled up to the seat to hold pressure on the brake peddle.
- 5. Jet ski trailers offer a unique challenge due to the high profile and very short trailer length.

 This requires backing the tow vehicle well into the water resulting in both the front and rear wheels being in the water and a likely candidate for a full vehicle wash in the lake. I recommend using the north ramp by the playground. It is not too steep and it has gravel and sand on the approach.
- 6. When back your trailer down the ramp, put the transmission in neutral rather than in reverse. Otherwise, your transmission is working against your brakes. The transmission reverse wins over the rear brakes!
