A special call meeting was held May 23rd to vote for amending the language of L.S.I.O.T.'s Articles of Incorporation. There were 154 votes in favor of the proposed amendment and 4 votes against. The new language will read:

“The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to carry out the functions of a property owners’ association, including but not limited to: obtaining, managing, constructing, and maintaining the property in a residential real estate development; promulgating and enforcing rules and regulations; making assessments; and charging fees and dues.”

The maintenance department is currently treating for mosquitos as needed and will continue to do so throughout the year to help control the population. As homeowners, you can also help by keeping grass mowed down, avoid over watering the lawn, and eliminating any standing water around the home. Also, companies like Panhandle Greenhouses and Prochem offer several safe products that can be applied around the home to help control the mosquito population.

New fuel dispensers have been ordered to replace our old ones, including the boat dock. They are expected to be installed by mid-June, and at that time the fuel pumps will be temporarily out of service for three to four days during installation. A notice will be posted on the main marquee regarding the date of installation.

FICTION

BEARTOWN (*Fredrik Backman*) A poignant, charming novel about a forgotten town fractured by scandal, and the amateur hockey team that might just change everything.

THE BROKEN ROAD (*Richard Paul Evans*) Coming from a childhood of poverty and pain, Chicago celebrity Charles James now has all he has ever wanted – fame, fans, and fortune. But he's started to wonder if he's wanted the wrong things. When he learns that one of his customers committed suicide because of financial ruin, Charles is shaken. Then a twist of fate changes everything. Charles is granted a second chance. The question is: What will he do with it?

INTO THE WATER (*Paula Hawkins*) A single mother turns up dead at the bottom of the river that runs through town, the latest victim lost to these dark waters, and the one whose death dredges up secrets long submerged. Left behind is her lonely 15-year-old daughter, who now finds herself in the care of her mother's sister, a fearful stranger who has been dragged back to the place she deliberately ran from and to where she vowed she'd never return.

EDGAR AND LUCY (*Vicktor Lodato*) Edgar, 8, knows that his father is gone, his mother has a limp, and his grandmother believes in ghosts. But he does not know why. When he meets a man with his own tragic story, Edgar begins a journey to a place where even the line between the living and the dead is not clear, and his mother, Lucy, has no choice but to confront the demons of her past.

COME SUNDOWN (*Nora Roberts*) The Bodine ranch and resort in western Montana is a family business, an idyllic spot for vacationers. It's kept running by Bodine Longbow with the help of a large staff, including new hire Callen Skinner. There was another member of the family once: Bodine's Aunt Alice, who ran off before Bodine was born. She never returned, and the younger ones quietly presume she's dead. But she isn't – and the twisted story Alice has to tell, and the threat that follows in her wake, will thrust Bodine into a darkness she could never have imagined.

THE ENGLISH SPY (*Daniel Silva*) A bomb explodes aboard a holiday yacht, killing an iconic member of the British royal family who is beloved by the public, but resented by her ex-husband and his mother, the Queen. British intelligence turns to legendary spy and assassin Gabriel Allon to track down the killer, a mercenary who sells his services to the highest bidder.

ANYTHING IS POSSIBLE (*Elizabeth Strout*) Two sisters: One trades self-respect for a wealthy husband, while the other finds in the pages of a book a kindred spirit who changes her life. The janitor at the local school has his faith tested in an encounter with an isolated man he has come to help; a grown daughter longs for mother's love even as she comes to accept her mother's happiness is in a foreign country; and the adult Lucy Barton returns to visit her siblings after seventeen years of absence.

NON-FICTION

MILK AND HONEY (*Rupi Kaur*) A collection of poetry and prose about survival. About the experience of violence, abuse, love, loss, and femininity.

BIOGRAPHY

MY MOTHER'S KITCHEN (*Peter Gethers*) Peter Gethers wants to give his aging mother a very personal and perhaps final gift: a spectacular feast featuring all her favorite dishes. The problem is, although he was raised to love food and wine, he doesn't know how to cook. He embarks upon an often hilarious and always touching culinary journey that will ultimately allow him to bring his mother's friends and loved ones to the table one last time.

AUDIO

BEARTOWN (*Fredrik Backman*) A poignant, charming novel about a forgotten town fractured by scandal, and the amateur hockey team that might just change everything.

BRITT MARIE WAS HERE (*Fredrik Backman*) When Britt-Marie walks out on her cheating husband she is drawn into the daily doings of her fellow citizens. And she is given the impossible task of leading the untalented children's soccer team to victory. In a town of big-hearted misfits, can she find a place where she truly belongs?

BLOOD FLAG (*Steve Martini*) Defending a client accused of killing her father, attorney Paul Madriani is drawn into a treacherous conspiracy dating to WWII. When Paul's young assistant, Sofia, is murdered, Madriani realizes that his client's fears are well-founded.

THE WOMAN IN CABIN 10 (*Ruth Ware*) Lo, a travel writer, has been assigned to a week on a luxury cruise with only a handful of cabins. At first the cruise seems idyllic – until she witnesses a woman being thrown overboard. But all the passengers remain accounted for, and the ship sails on as if nothing has happened. Something (or someone) has gone terribly, terribly wrong.

FAST AND LOOSE (*Stuart Woods*) While enjoying a boating excursion off the coast of Maine, Stone Barrington makes the acquaintance of a prestigious family. They require a man of Stone's skills to overcome a sticky situation with an enemy they have in common – an enemy who regards any defeat as a personal and intolerable insult. And when Stone's cunning collides with his adversary's hair-trigger temper, the results are sure to be explosive!
