Soon we will have another possible option for internet services. We have an agreement with AWBroadband to install equipment at three different locations to provide high speed internet. We do not yet know when installation will be complete but will inform the community when they have everything up and running. Please keep in mind that some locations may not be able to access this service due to terrain (canyon walls and trees).

The maintenance department will be treating for mosquitos as needed throughout the year to help control the population. As homeowners, you can also help by keeping grass mowed down, avoid over watering the lawn, and eliminating any standing water around the home. Also, companies like Panhandle Greenhouses and Pro-chem offer several safe products that can be applied around the home to help control the mosquito population.

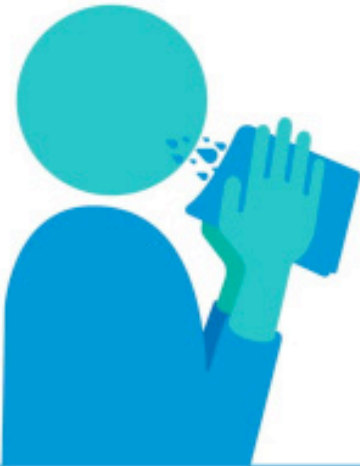


## REMEMBER THE 3 C's!

**FICTION**

**The Night Portrait** by Laura Monelli – *Historical Fiction*

A tale told in two historical periods follows da Vinci's ambitious 1492 creation of *Portrait of a Lady with an Ermine* and a conservator's life-risking effort to save the painting from Nazi destruction centuries later.

**The Midnight Library** by Matt Haig - *Science Fiction/Time Travel*

Between life and death there is a library, and within that library, the shelves go on forever. Every book provides a chance to try another life and to see how things would be if you had made other choices.

**The Clockmaker's Daughter** by Kate Morton/Jane Froggatt – *Historical Fiction*

Told by multiple voices across time, is a story of murder, mystery, and thievery, of art, love and loss. Flowing through its pages like a river, is the voice of a woman who stands outside time, whose name has been forgotten by history, but who has watched it all unfold: Birdie Bell, the clockmaker's daughter.

**Deadlock** by Catherine Coulter – *Historical Fiction*

Targeted by a vengeful psychopath out to destroy his family, Savich receives three mysterious boxes containing clues leading to an unfamiliar community and a young wife who must confront a decades-old secret.

**The Vanishing Half** – by Brit Bennett – *Women's Fiction*

Separated by their embrace of different racial identities, two mixed-race identical twins reevaluate their choices as one raises a black daughter in their southern hometown while the other passes for white with a husband who is unaware of her heritage.

**Thunder Dog** by Michael Hingson – *Biography*

In *Thunder Dog*, follow Michael and his guide dog, Roselle, as their lives are changed forever by two explosions and 1,463 stairs. In this harrowing story of trust and courage, discover how blindness and a bond between dog and man saved lives and brought hope during one of America's darkest days.

**Dark Witch** by Nora Roberts - *Romance*

An American searches for her Irish ancestors to learn more about her powers and break an ancient curse in the first book of a new trilogy, *The Cousins O'Dwyer Trilogy*, from the New York Times best-selling author of more than 200 novels.

**Double Tap** by Steve Martini/Mantegna, Joe – *Thriller/Suspense*

Defense attorney Paul Madriani takes on the case of Emiliano Ruiz, a career soldier on trial for the murder of a businesswoman and the head of a high-tech software company, murders that could be tied to explosive government secrets.

Village Ordinance requires most construction project to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (as outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT) or online at [www.laketanglewood.org](http://www.laketanglewood.org)

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon the Friday prior to a Building Committee meeting (Wednesday).

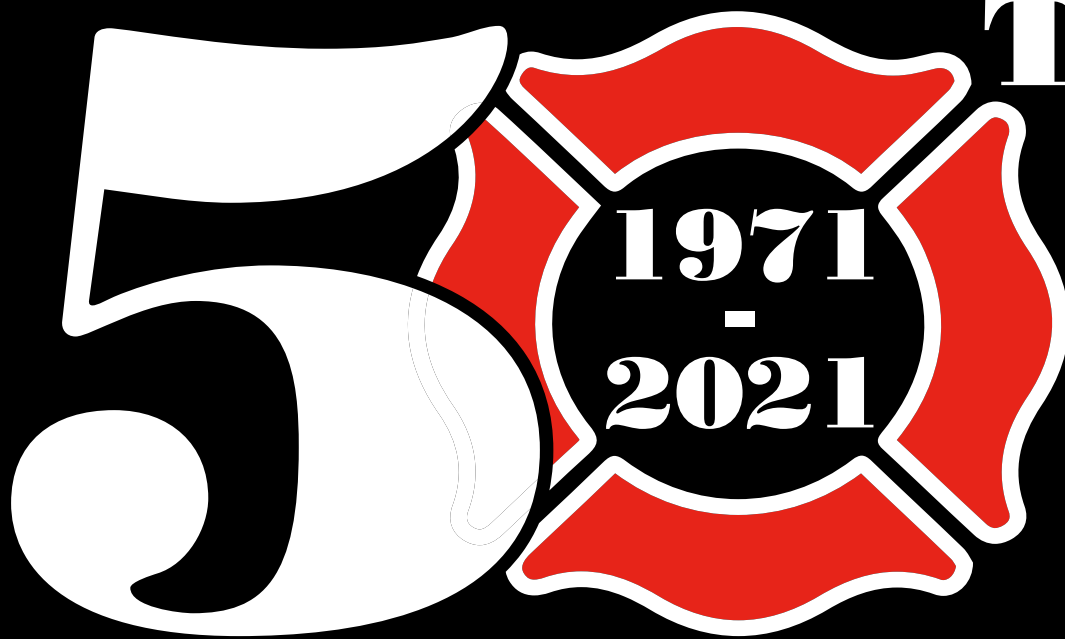
