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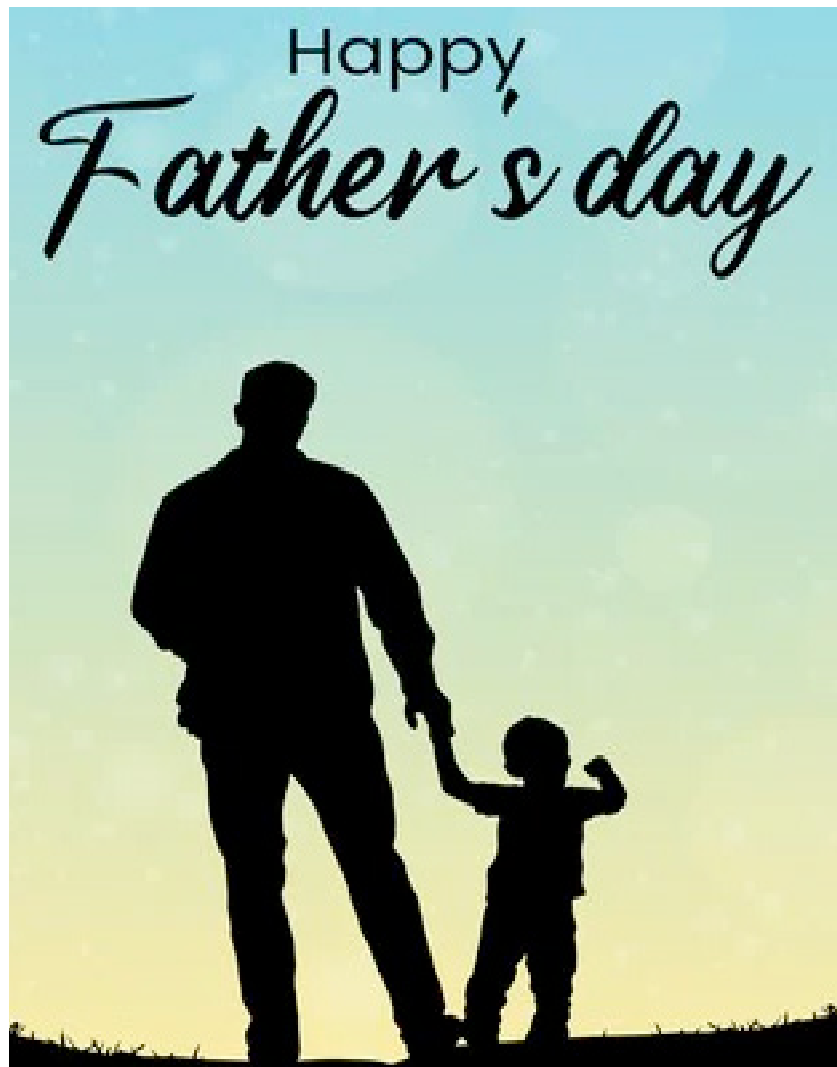

A couple of things to note, when you swing your club and take grass from the golf course or tee box it is called divot. I have noticed and our groundskeepers also have seen evidence of people making big divots and not repairing them. Please take the time to pour some sand or replace the grass that you've knocked from the ground. We are tearing up tee boxes at a rate faster than they can repair themselves.

You may began to see " NO CARTS" Signs being placed on the golf course. Please adhere to the signs and do not take your car beyond the signs.

One last thing I have had several phone calls concerning people driving golf carts near the putting greens. I have seen this myself and is normally not acceptable. We have players that are at or over the age of 80 that play on a regular basis. They do drive near the putting greens.
