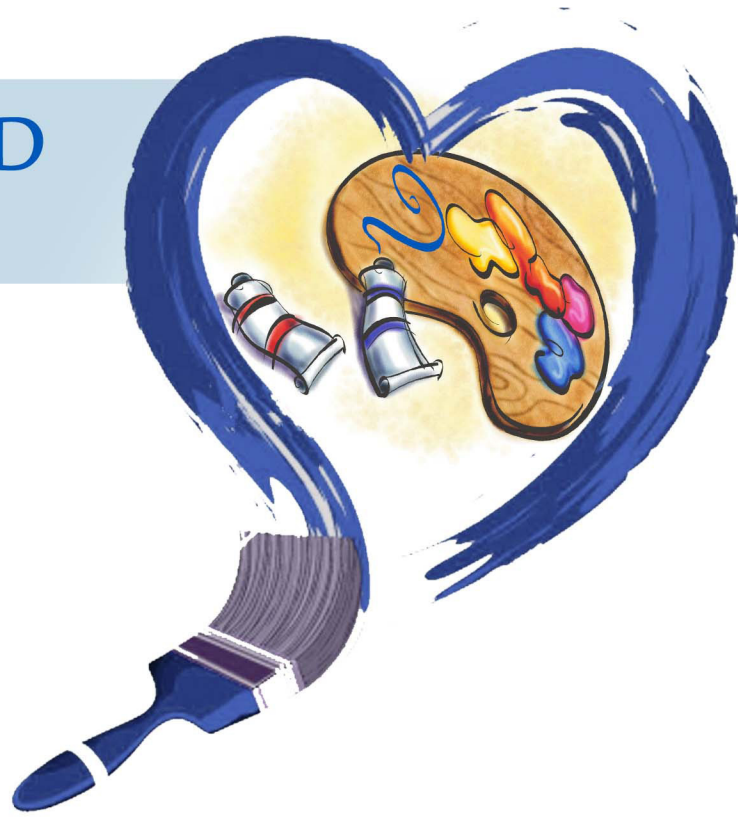

FICTION

FIND HER, by Lisa Gardner. Kidnapped on spring break, Flora was held captive for 472 days. Now she attempts to recover her life. Boston Detective D.D. Warren must figure out if Flora is a victim or a vigilante. When she disappears again, D.D. must track a sinister predator who is determined that this time, Flora will never escape. Eighth in the series.

PLAYING WITH FIRE, by Tess Gerritsen. Determined to track down the origins of a piece of music that has a terrifying effect on her daughter, Julia travels to Venice. She discovers a dark secret that dates back to WWII involving a dangerously powerful family who will stop at nothing to keep her from bringing the truth to light.

AFTER WE FALL, by Emma Kavanagh. A plane crash rocks a sleepy little town. When a murder follows on tragedy's heels and dark secrets are unearthed, no one will be left standing

BREAKDOWN, by Jonathan Kellerman. A former client of psychologist Alex Delaware, beautiful and emotionally fragile TV actress Zelda Chase, is discovered dead on the grounds of a Bel Air estate. Her son is missing, and when other victims vanish from the same upscale neighborhood, Alex and LAPD detective Milo Sturgis are determined to find the answers.

AFTER ALICE, by Gregory Maguire. Ada, a friend of Alice's, is off to visit her friend, but arrives a moment too late and tumbles down the rabbit-hole herself. She embarks on an odyssey to find Alice and see her safely home from Wonderland, this surreal world below the world.

NYPD RED 4, by James Patterson. When a glitzy movie premiere is the scene of a shocking murder and high-stakes robbery, NYPD Red gets the call. Traversing the city's highs and lows, from celebrity penthouses to the depths of Manhattan's criminal underworld, Detective Zach Jordan and his partner, Kylie MacDonald, have to find a cold-blooded killer before he strikes again. Fourth in the series.

NON FICTION

THE ROAD TO LITTLE DRIBBLING, by Bill Bryson. Two decades after the trip that resulted in *Notes from a Small Island*, Bryson set out to revisit England in all its glorious eccentricity. A hilarious and loving sequel.

BEFORE I FORGOT, by B. Smith. Restaurateur, magazine publisher, celebrity chef, and nationally known lifestyle maven, B. Smith is struggling at 66 with a tag she never expected to add to that string: Alzheimer's patient. She's not alone. Every 67 seconds someone newly develops it, and millions of lives are affected by its aftershocks.

AUDIO

THE EX, by Alafair Burke. Top New York criminal defense lawyer Olivia hears that her former fiance has been arrested for a triple homicide. She is sure of his innocence, and representing him is a way to make up for past regrets. But as the evidence against him mounts, she must confront her doubts. Did she ever really know him?

PLAYING WITH FIRE, by Tess Gerritsen. Determined to track down the origins of a piece of music that has a terrifying effect on her daughter, Julia travels to Venice. LAFAYETTE IN THE SOMEWHAT UNITED STATES, by Sarah Vowell. The swashbuckling, teenage, French aristocrat was George Washington's trusted friend and officer. Riding shotgun with him, Vowell swerves from debates at Independence Hall to frozen Valley Forge, from bloody battlefields to the Palace of Versailles. Along the way he bumps into John Adams, Thomas Jefferson, Lord Cornwallis, Marie Antoinette, and others.

GLASS CASTLES, by Jeannette Walls. Growing up in a dysfunctional family, amid poverty and neglect, Jeannette and her siblings fended for themselves. They supported one another as they weathered their parents' betrayals and, finally, found the resources and will to leave home.

AFTERWORLDS, by Scott Westerfeld. Darcy has put college on hold to publish her teen novel, Afterworlds. She arrives in New York City with no apartment, no friends, and all the wrong clothes. Luckily, she's taken under the wings of other seasoned and fledgling writers who help her navigate the city and the world of writing and publishing. Over the course of a year, Darcy finishes her book, faces critique, and falls in love.
