The First Lady by James Patterson/Brendan Dubois – *Thrillers/Political*

One secret could bring down the government when the President's memorable affair becomes a nightmare he longs to forget. The First Lady's absence comes in the wake of the scandalous, public revelation of the affair, so at first it seems as though she is simply cutting off all contact as she recuperates at a horse farm in Virginia. What begins as an innocent respite quickly turns into a twisted case when the White House receives a ransom note along with the First Lady's finger.

A Minute to Midnight by David Baldacci – *Thrillers/Suspense* – Part of Atlee Pine Thriller series

FBI Agent Atlee Pine's life was never the same after her twin sister Mercy was kidnapped – and likely killed – thirty years ago. After a lifetime of torturous uncertainty, Atlee's unresolved anger finally gets the better of her on the job, and she finds she must deal with the demons of her past if she wants to remain with the FBI. Atlee is determined to continue her search for answers and finding a potential serial killer before another victim is claimed.

The Black Widow by Daniel Silva – *Thriller/Espionage* - Part of the Gabriel Allon series

Art restorer, assassin, and spy Gabriel Allon finds himself poised to become the chief of Israel's secret intelligence service, but not before answering the French government's request to eliminate the person responsible for detonating a massive bomb in Paris.

Beyond The Ice Limit by Douglas Preston/Lincoln Child – *Thriller* - Part of the Gideon Crew series

Five years after a giant meteorite from deep space sank to the ocean floor after a failed recovery effort, the discovery that the meteorite is actually a complex organism that is now growing and could destroy life on Earth leads to a high-stakes assignment for Gideon Crew.

The Steel Kiss by Jeffery Deaver - *Thriller* - Part of the Lincoln Thyme series

Amelia Sachs is hot on the trail of a killer. She's chasing him through a department store in Brooklyn when an escalator malfunctions. The stairs give way, with one man horribly mangled by the gears. Sachs is forced to let her quarry escape as she jumps in to try to help save the victim. She and detective Lincoln Rhyme soon learn, however, that the incident may not have been an accident at all, but the first in a series of intentional attacks. They find themselves up against one of their most formidable opponents ever: a brilliant killer who turns common products into murder weapons.

Building Permits

Village Ordinance requires most construction project to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (as outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT) or online at www.laketanglewood.org

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon the Friday prior to a Building Committee meeting (Wednesday).
