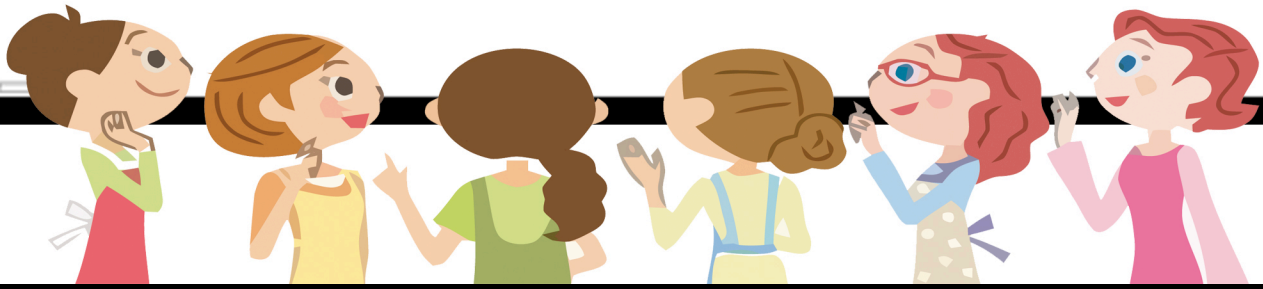

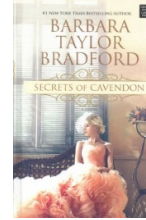
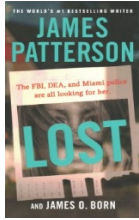

FICTION

Lost by James Patterson and James O. Born – *Thrillers/Crime*

As leader of the FBI task force called “Operation Guardian,” it is Miami Detective Tom Moon’s mission to combat international crime. Moon’s investigative team discovers that the opportunistic “Blood Brothers” - Russian nationals Roman and Emile Rostoff – have evaded authorities while building a vast, powerful and deadly crime syndicate throughout Europe and metropolitan Miami.

Chosen Ones by Veronica Roth – *Fantasy/Contemporary*

The first novel written for an adult audience by the mega-selling author of the *Divergent* franchise: five twenty-something heroes famous for saving the world when they were teenagers must face even greater demons - and reconsider what it means to be a hero....by destiny or by choice.

The Flight Girls by Noelle Salazar – *Historical/World War II*

Signing up to train pilots in Hawaii when World War II breaks out in Europe, Audrey Coltrain joins the Women Airforce Service Pilots (WASP) program after the bombing of Pearl Harbor and bonds with her fellow pilots to find hope and strength in the face of war.

The Nature of Fragile Things by Susan Meissner – *Historical/General* -- April 18, 1906 San Francisco earthquake/fire

Sophie Whalen, a young Irish immigrant so desperate to get out of a New York tenement that she answers a mail-order bride ad and agrees to marry a man she knows nothing about. Widower Martin Hocking proves to be as aloof as he is mesmerizingly handsome. Sophie quickly develops deep affection for Kat, Martin’s silent five-year-old daughter, but Martin’s odd behavior leaves her with the uneasy feeling that something about her newfound situation isn’t right.

The Neighbors by Nancy Bush – *Mystery & Detective/Private Investigators* - Part of the *River Glen* series

Reluctantly moving to the Villages – a luxury development - as bodyguard to the Carrera family, Mackenzie Laughlin, expecting petty squabbles and drama to be the cause of this job, is instead trapped in the world of squalid affairs, sinister disappearances and murder.

Hush by James Patterson and Candice Fox - *Thrillers/Crime* – part of the *Harriet Blue* series

An imprisoned ex-cop seeking justice for her brother’s murder is offered her freedom in exchange for helping the Deputy Police Commissioner who put her away rescue his missing daughter and grandchild.

Secrets of Cavendon by Barbara Taylor Bradford - *Historical/General*

It’s the summer of 1949, and things have run smoothly at Cavendon Hall for years, with very few quarrels, dramas, or upsets between the two families. But since the end of World War II, changes have arrived at Cavendon. A new generation is at the helm, and also at the forefront of new scandal and intrigue.

Dark Summer by Iris Johansen - *Romance/Suspense*

Working with a makeshift search-and-rescue operation, dedicated veterinarian Devon is thrust into a violent cat-and-mouse game involving a vengeful man of dubious trustworthiness and a wounded black Labrador’s mysterious pack.
