





March Holidays:

<u>The Ides of March</u> is the day on the Roman calendar marked as the *Idus*, roughly the midpoint of a month, of Martius, corresponding to **15 March** on the Gregorian calendar. It was marked by several major religious observances. In 44 BC, it became notorious as the date of the assassination of Julius Caesar, which made the Ides of March a turning point in Roman history.

<u>Saint Patrick's Day, or the Feast of Saint Patrick</u> is a religious and cultural holiday held on 17 March, the traditional death date of Saint Patrick (c. 385 - c. 461), the foremost patron saint of Ireland. The day commemorates Saint Patrick and the arrival of Christianity in Ireland. It is celebrated in more countries than any other national festival.

Spring Equinox

Astronomically speaking, the first day of spring is marked by the spring equinox, which falls on **20 March** in 2025. The Spring Equinox happens on the specific moment in time when the Sun is directly above the Earth's equator, which happens when the Sun is crossing the celestial equator, an imaginary line above the equator, from South to North. This occurs at the same time everywhere in the World, however, the date and time of the Equinox vary from country to country due to the year that it happens in and the time zones. This date only signals spring's beginning in the Northern Hemisphere; it announces fall's arrival in the Southern Hemisphere. On the equinox, both hemispheres receive equal amounts of sunlight.


