A spring cleaning day has been scheduled for May 19th. 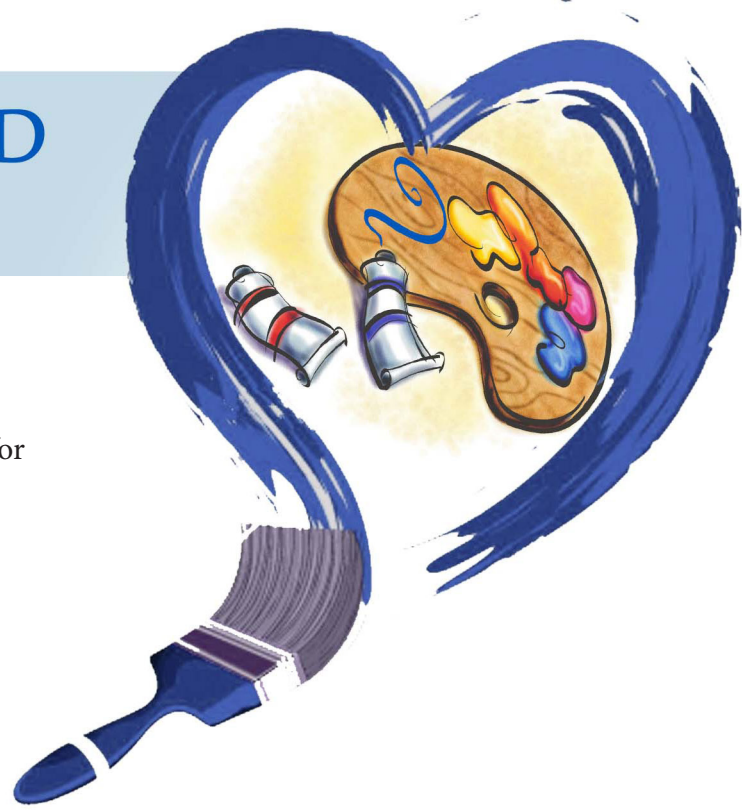
Meet at 9:30 at the activities club house and go to Cracker Barrel for breakfast. We can ride together and do some shopping.

LT Lions continues to support & serve our community. It was decided in April that the Lions Club would support the Russell Activity Center (RAC) with a \$15,000 donation. The RAC will add value to Lake Tanglewood. It will take an "eyesore on the hill" and turn it into an attractive athletic area (RAC) which will feature tennis court, basketball court, pickle ball court, restrooms, youth center, and an indoor gym area. All areas will be ADA compliant.

Lake Tanglewood has had outdoor summer areas for the neighborhood youth and young children: lake, golf course, sand volleyball, playground, and many trails for hiking. Coming soon, the RAC will have resurfaced basketball court, tennis court, a new pickle ball court, a new indoor gym area, indoor bathrooms and an enclosed youth area. During the winter months, families will be able to play sports with their children indoors.

The RAC committee will only spend the money that has been donated/raised. As donations come in, more phases of the project will be completed. Demolition of the existing area started the end of April. At this time, court resurfacing & bathrooms will be the next phase. Indoor gym will be the next phase. The remaining phase will be lighting, fencing, safety pads in gym, outdoor benches, and landscaping.
