As of this writing, the rules on our golf course are as follows.

1. The course will be closed Monday and Tuesday, open Wed. – Sunday.
2. Only one person per golf cart, unless living in the same household, otherwise, you'll need to walk.
3. No groups larger than 4 players.
4. Maintain the social distance of 6 feet.
5. The clubhouse and patio are closed.

The cups are placed above ground to prevent anyone from handling the flag. My group is playing it as follows. If your ball touches the cup it is considered holed out unless the ball bounces outside “the leather” then your ball is not holed out and still in play.

As busy as the golf course is now, it's important to be considerate of other players.

Etiquette! If you intend on starting on hole #10, please don't jump in front of players on hole #9.

Pace of play.

For beginner golfers the front 9 should take no more than 90 minutes to play, the back 9 should take no more than 2 hours.

I have had a bunch of scorecards made. Since the club house is closed, you can email me and request some, or see me on the course and I'll get you some.

### Building Permits

*Village Ordinance requires most construction projects to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries. Failure to obtain a permit may result in a substantial fine.*

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT), or online at [www.laketanglewood.org](http://www.laketanglewood.org)

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon on the Friday of the week prior to the Building Committee Meeting to be considered.

Roofing Permits can be obtained during normal business hours, with the submission of a Roofing Permit application.
