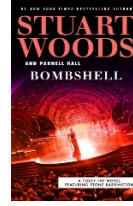
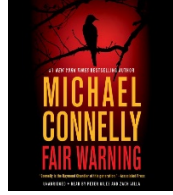
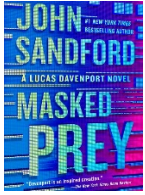

Masked Prey by John Sanford – *Crime* – A Lucas Davenport Novel series

Lucas Davenport investigates a vitriolic blog that seems to be targeting the children of U.S. politicians. With nowhere else to turn, influential Senators decide to call in someone who can operate outside the FBI's constraints: Lucas Davenport.

Princess by James Patterson and Rees Jones - *Thriller/Suspense* - Part of the *Private* series

A secret and the British crown make a murderous combination in this page-turning suspense novel. Investigator Jack Morgan is invited to meet Princess Caroline and soon discovers that he is to locate a close friend of the princess before the media catches wind of the scandal.

Fair Warning by Michael Connelly - *Thriller/Legal* - Part of the *Jack McEvoy* series

Veteran reporter Jack McEvoy has taken down killers before, but when a woman he had a one-night stand with is murdered in a particularly brutal way, McEvoy realizes he might be facing a criminal mind unlike any he's ever encountered.

Anxious People by Fredrik Backman - *Literary Fiction* -

Taken hostage by a failed bank robber while attending an open house, eight anxiety-prone strangers – including a redemption-seeking bank director, two couples who would fix their marriages, and a plucky octogenarian—discover their unexpected common traits.

Bombshell by Stuart Woods - *Action and Adventure* - Part of the *Teddy Fay* series

Teddy Fay, a former CIA-operative-turned-movie-producer is accustomed to hazardous working conditions; however, when returning to La-La Land this time, Teddy will need to leverage every bit of his undercover skills and fearless daring to stay one step ahead of his foes.....or he'll find himself one foot in the grave.

Dark Sky by C. J. Box - *Crime* – Part of the *Joe Pickett* series

Joe Pickett reluctantly accompanies a Silicon Valley tech baron on an elk hunting trip in the Wyoming wilderness. As they venture into the woods, a sharpshooting man-hunter is hot on their heels, driven by a desire for revenge. Joe soon learns that he himself may be the hunted. Finding himself without a weapon, a horse, or a way to communicate, Joe must rely on his wits and his knowledge of the outdoors to protect himself and his companion.

The Last Bookshop in London by Madeline Martin – *Historical Fiction/World War II*

August 1939: Amidst the blackouts and air raids of the Blitz in London, Grace Bennett begins working at a dusty old bookshop, Primrose Hill, where she discovers the power of storytelling to unite her community in ways she never dreamed – a force that triumphs over even the darkest nights of the war.
