**FICTION**

**The Inn** – by James Patterson - Thrillers/Crime

In this action-packed thriller, a quiet seafront town is targeted by vicious criminals, leaving locals no choice but to team up and save the place they love.

**The Fallen** by David Baldacci - Thriller/Suspense - #1 *New York Times* bestseller

Star FBI detective Amos Decker and his colleague Alex Jamison must solve four increasingly bizarre murders in a dying rust belt town. The closer they come to the truth, the deadlier it gets in this rapid-fire bestseller.

**Countdown** by Iris Johansen - Thrillers/Suspense - Part of the Eve Duncan Series - #1 *New York Times* author

This will definitely jump start our fishing in the next few years. We will continue to do a maintenance stocking from year to year as we monitor hatches, growth rates, and movement around the lake. Many thanks to everyone who has contributed time and money to this important part of our lake life. We will also construct and locate more structures in the lake as part of our habitat rebuilding goals in the late winter/early spring.

## Building Permits

Village Ordinance requires most construction project to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (as outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT) or online at [www.laketanglewood.org](http://www.laketanglewood.org)

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon the Friday prior to a Building Committee meeting (Wednesday).
