***Each family attending is asked to bring a vegetable dish or salad that will feed 8 or more people. Please do not bring serving pieces for your dishes.**

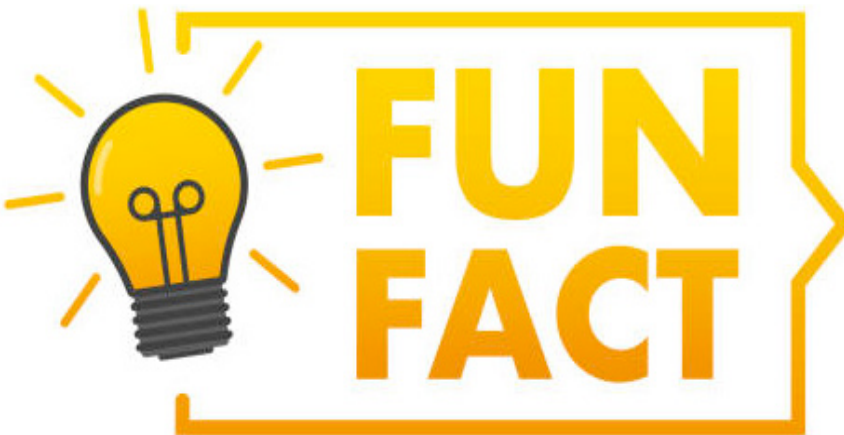
