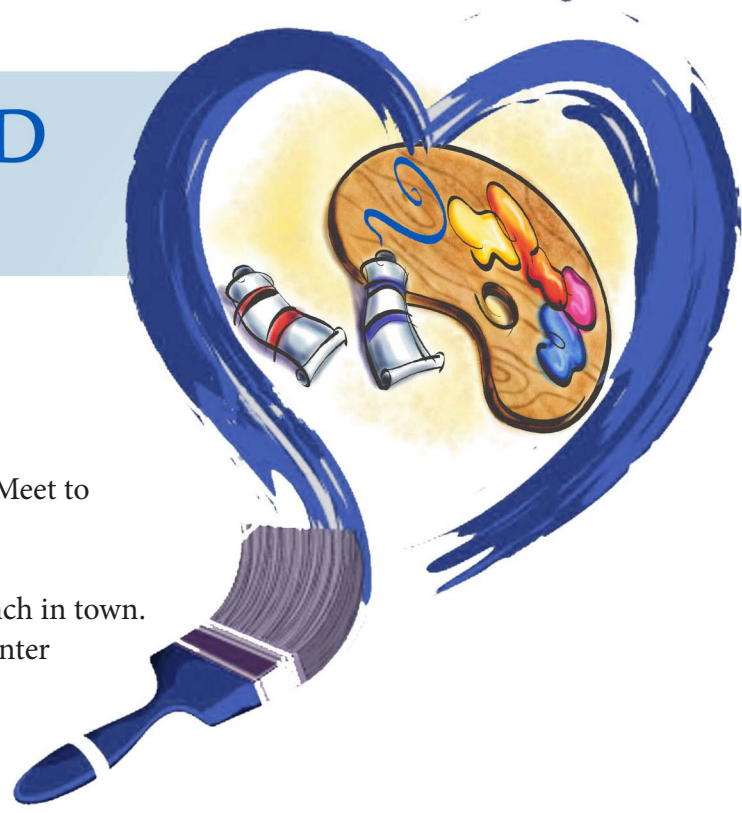

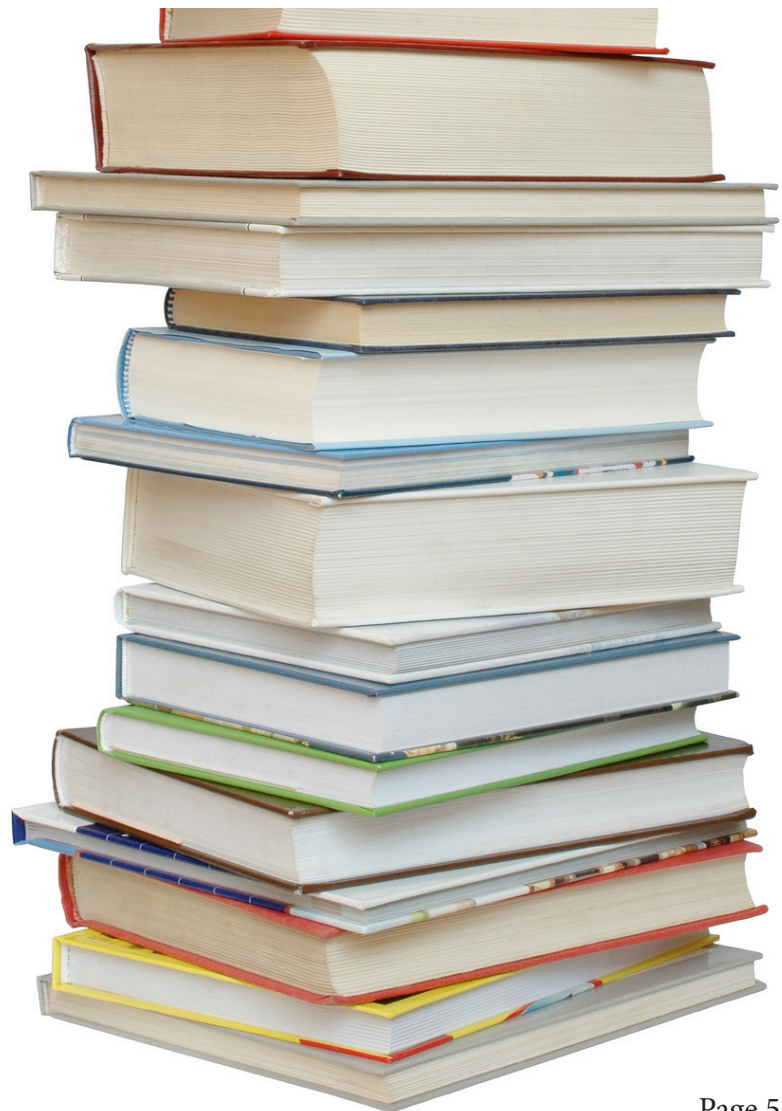

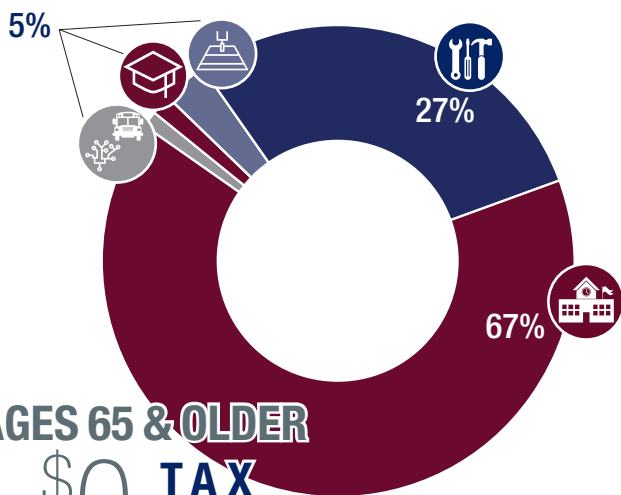

ADDRESS STUDENT GROWTH

- » **New High School #3** will serve 1,200 students (core facilities able to serve up to 1,500), located in the Northwest area of the district and scheduled to open August 2022.
- » **New Elementary School #9**, located on the North side of the school district, will serve 750 students and is scheduled to open 2020.
- » **Elementary School #10**, located on the South side of the school district, will serve 500 students initially (core to serve 750 students) and is scheduled to open 2021.

RENOVATIONS & UPGRADES

- » **Randall High School** addition to increase student capacity. Add secure entry.
- » **Randall East** addition to convert to a third junior high, with proposed completion in 2022. Add secure entry.
- » **Sundown Lane Elementary School** secure entry, building repairs, interior and exterior upgrades.
- » **Canyon Intermediate School** secure entry, upgrades to classrooms and lockers.
- » **Canyon Junior High School** secure entry, new science labs, new exterior doors, lockers and upgrades.
- » **Kimbrough Stadium** fieldhouse, scoreboard relocation, new lighting, ADA improvements and lower south hill.
- » **Canyon High School Baseball and Softball** new concessions and restrooms and parking improvements.

- » **Infrastructure for WiFi access and online safety** includes district-wide technology connectivity and increased bandwidth

CAREER & TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION (CTE) EXPANSION

- » **Expansion of CTE** classroom space and program offerings
- » **Expansion of Agriculture Building** for the Manufacturing Academy

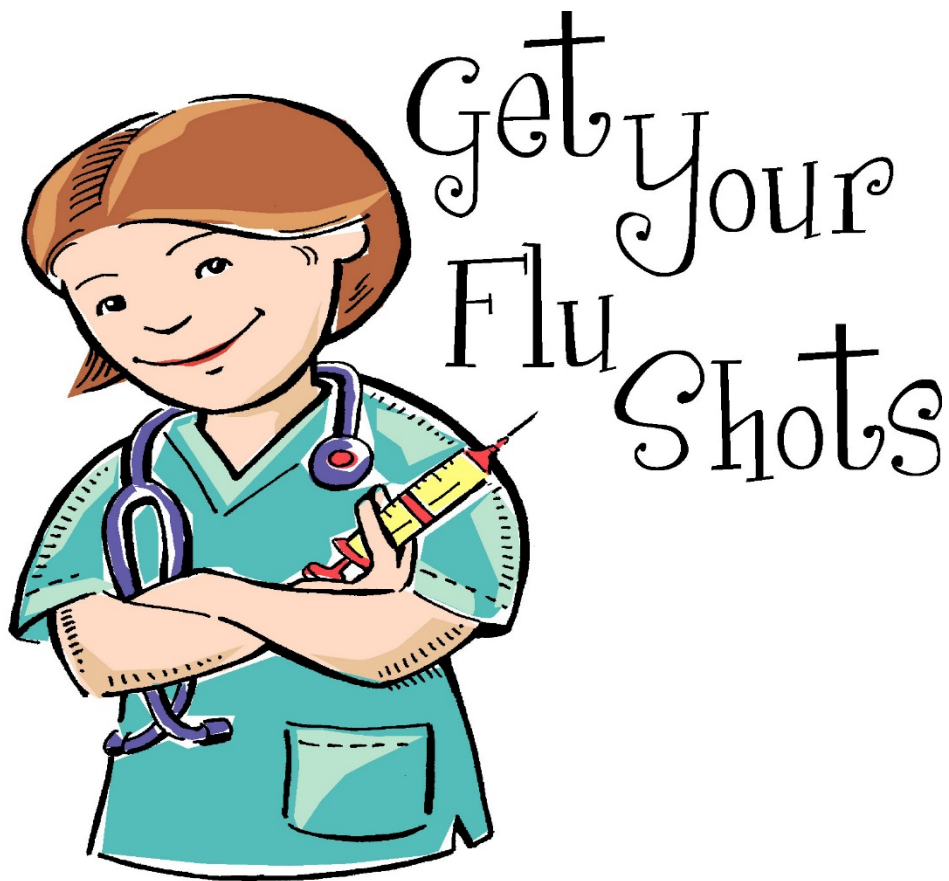
