FICTION

A Well-Behaved Woman by Therese Ann Fowler – *Historical/Gilded Age*

The riveting novel of iron-willed Alva Vanderbilt and her illustrious family as they rule Gilded-Age New York. *Therese Anne Fowler* is the *New York Times* bestselling author of *Z: A Novel of Zelda Fitzgerald*.

Karolina's Twins by Ronald H. Balson – *Historical/General/WWII*

From the author of *Once We Were Brothers* comes a saga inspired by true events of a Holocaust survivor's quest to fulfill a promise, return to Poland and find two sisters lost during World War II.

Unsolved by James Patterson and David Ellis – *Thrillers/Crime* – (part of the Invisible series)

In this follow-up to the #1 bestselling thriller *Invisible*, every perfect murder looks like an accident, but as bodies start to pile up across the country, two FBI agents realize that something horrible is happening.

The Escape Artist by Brad Meltzer – *Thrillers/Military*

Nola Brown, the U.S. Army's artist-in-residence--a painter and trained soldier--sees something nobody was supposed to see and earns a dangerous enemy in this novel as powerful as "a launched torpedo slashing through 400 pages of deep water before reaching impact...one of the best thrill rides ever" (David Baldacci).

Relentless by Mark Greaney – *Thrillers/Espionage* – (part of the Gray Man series)

Attempting to secure an operative who is among several who have gone missing throughout the world, the Gray Man secures vital intelligence from a team of assassins, before an undercover agent in Berlin makes a life-threatening discovery.

NONFICTION

Walk In My Combat Boots by James Patterson and Matt Eversmann – *Biography/Autobiography/Military*

First Sergeant US Army (Ret.) Matt Eversmann, the decorated war hero who inspired the movie, *Black Hawk Down*, shares firsthand wartime accounts describing the courageous battlefield sacrifices of men and women from every branch and operational specialty of the U.S. military, from the Vietnam War through the present.

The Hardest Job in the World by John Dickerson – *Political Science/American Govt./Exec Branch*

The author writes about presidents in history—such as Washington, Lincoln, FDR and Eisenhower—and in contemporary times—from LBJ and Reagan to Bush, Obama, and Trump—to show how a complex job has been done, and why we need to reevaluate how we view the presidency, how we choose our presidents and what we expect from them once they are in office. Illustrations.

Modern Warriors by Pete Hegseth – *Political Science/American Govt./General*

The "Fox & Friends Weekend" cohost presents inspiring stories from fifteen highly decorated members of America's military, drawing on candid conversations to discuss what inspired them to serve, the realities of war, and the difficulty of transitioning back home.

Building Permits

Village Ordinance requires most construction project to obtain a building permit prior to beginning construction within Lake Tanglewood boundaries.

To obtain a Building Permit, a member must submit a Building Permit application and supplement documents (as outlined in the application). Building Permit applications are available at Village Hall, Lake Tanglewood Corporation Office (LSIOT) or online at www.laketanglewood.org

Completed applications and documents may be emailed or dropped off in person to Village Hall or the LSIOT Office.

Building Permit applications must be submitted no later than noon the Friday prior to a Building Committee meeting (Wednesday).
