You Don't Own Me – by Mary Higgins Clark/Alafair Burke – *Thrillers/Suspense* – Series: *Under Suspicion*

The perfect, exhilarating follow up to the bestselling *Every Breath You Take*. Television producer Laurie Moran must solve the murder of a celebrity doctor – before a mysterious stalker plots his next move.

Better Off Dead – by Lee Child/Andrew Child – *Thrillers/Suspense* – Series: *Jack Reacher*

An army veteran turned FBI agent is trying to find her twin brother, who might be mixed up with some dangerous people. Most of them would rather die than betray their terrifying leader, who has burrowed his influence deep into the nearby border town. Reacher isn't one to back down; when you pick a fight with Reacher, you're better off dead....

In The Blood – by Jack Carr – *Thrillers/Political* – Series: *The Terminal List*

A Mossad operative with ties to the intelligence services of two nations boards a plane in the African country of Burkina Faso having just completed a targeted assassination for the state of Israel. Two minutes later, her plane is blown out of the sky. Former Navy SEAL, James Reece, relies on allies around the world to track down who is responsible.

This Tender Land – by William Kent Krueger – *Literary Fiction* -

“If you liked *Where the Crawdads Sing*, you'll love *This Tender Land*” Parade. The unforgettable story of four orphans who travel the Mississippi River on a life-changing odyssey during the Great Depression. An enthralling, big-hearted epic that shows how the magnificent American landscape connects us, haunts our dreams, and makes us whole.

Invisible Girl – by Lisa Jewell – *Thrillers/Suspense*

Young Saffyre Maddox has spent three years under the care of renowned child psychologist, Roan Fours, when he decides their sessions should end. Saffyre, feeling abandoned, began looking for ways to connect with him, from waiting outside his office to walking through his neighborhood late at night, until she disappears, taking secrets with her.

The River Murders – by James Patterson/James O. Born – *Thrillers/Suspense* – Three tales in one volume -

A bind-up of three suspenseful tales includes the previously released *Hidden* and *Malicious* as well as the new thriller, *Malevolent*, in which private investigator Mitchum desperately hunts the perpetrator of attacks against his loved ones. Investigating three dangerous cases, he learns that chasing the truth means going to the point of no return.

One Step Too Far – by Lisa Gardner – *Mystery & Detective/Women Sleuths*

Searching for a young man who disappeared without a trace into the wilderness of Wyoming, missing expert and recovering alcoholic Frankie Elkin, with her very life on the line, goes up against something very dark to find what she is looking for. A desperate effort to find him uncovers secrets and the evil that awaits those who go too far.

A Slow Fire Burning – by Paula Hawkins – *Thrillers/Suspense* – by bestselling author of *The Girl on the Train*.

Three women unknown to each other are each questioned in connection with the gruesome murder of a young man found on a London houseboat. Three women who are – for different reasons – simmering with resentment, burning to right the wrongs done to them. When it comes to revenge, even good people might be capable of terrible deeds.
