We will attempt to bill Medicare Part B or D, or insurance for your vaccination if you agree to release personal information necessary to process this claim. If payment is denied, you agree to be personally responsible for payment of services as provided.

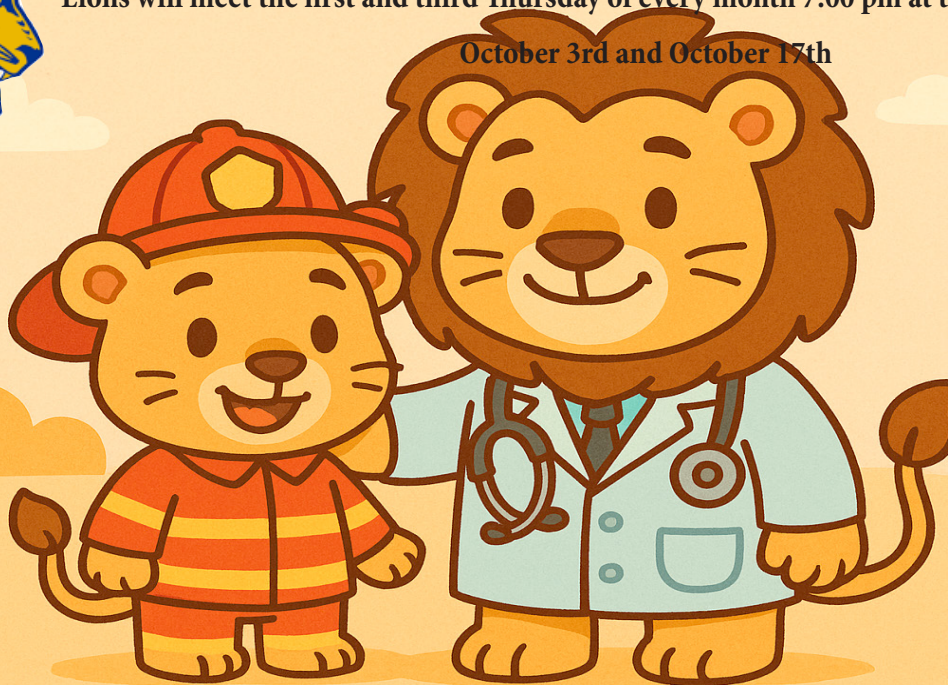
